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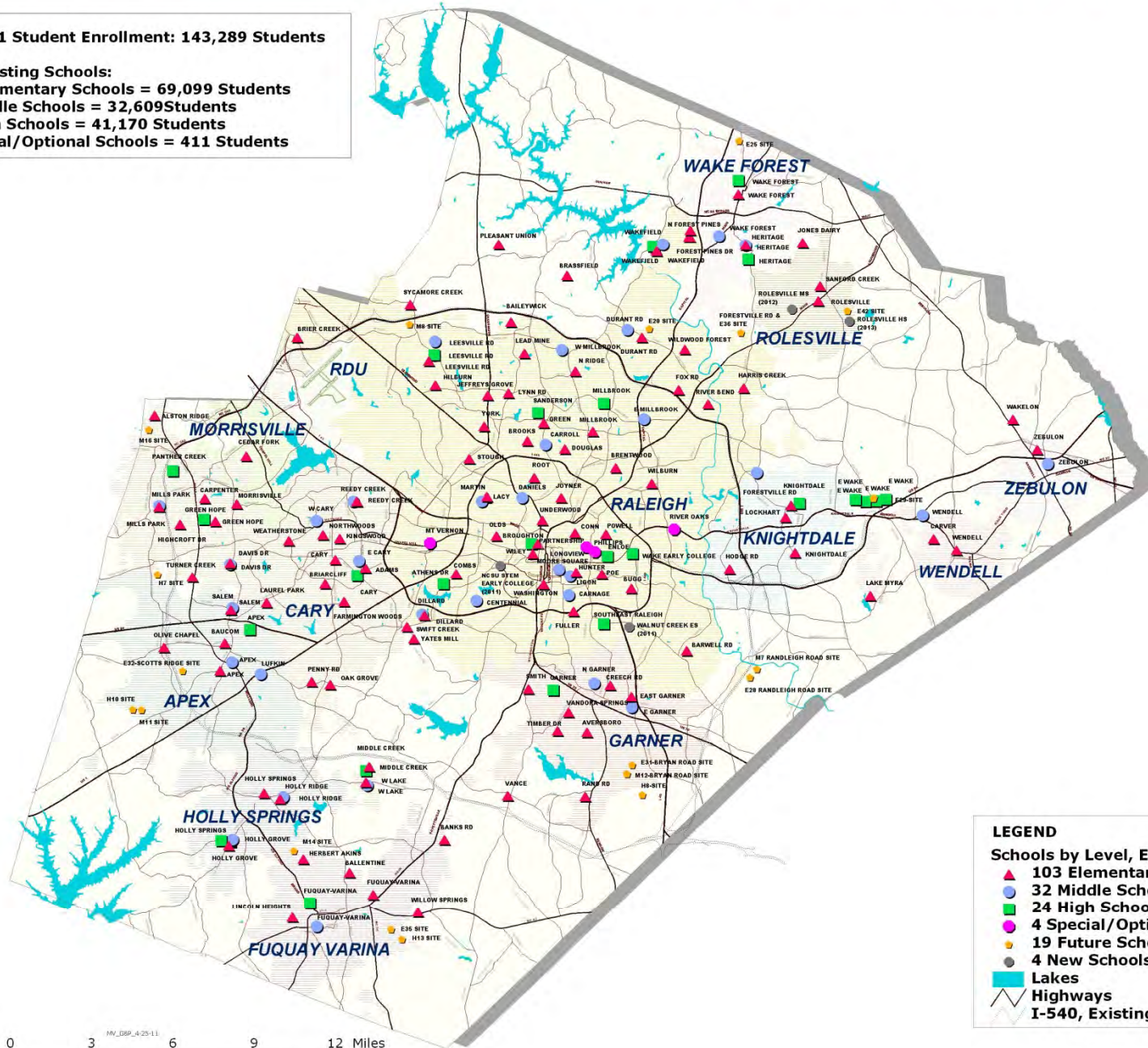

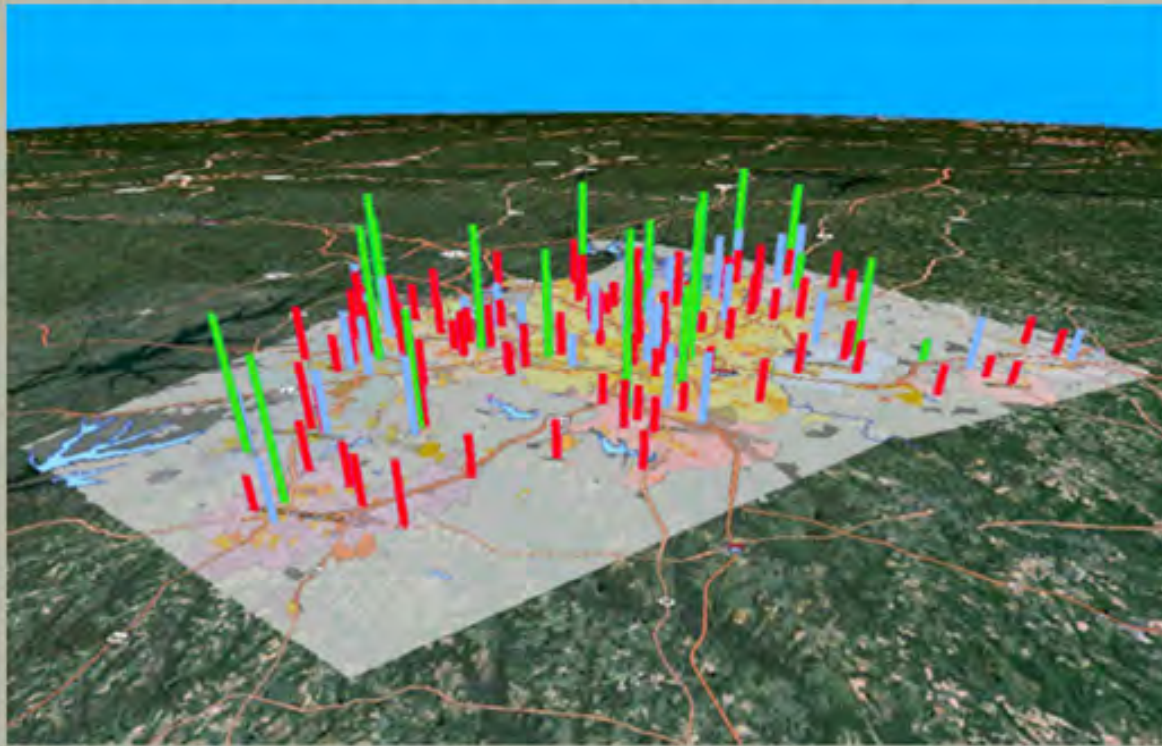

WCPSS has been **growing steadily** over the past two decades. There were 3,690 more students enrolled on the 20th day in 2010-2011 than on the 20th day in 2009-2010.

With the 2010-11 enrollment of **143,289**, WCPSS remains the **largest school district** in the state, and the **18th largest** school district in the nation.

Four **new schools opened in 2010-11**, bringing the total number of schools to **163**. There are **103 elementary**, **32 middle**, **24 high** and **4 special/optional** schools.
