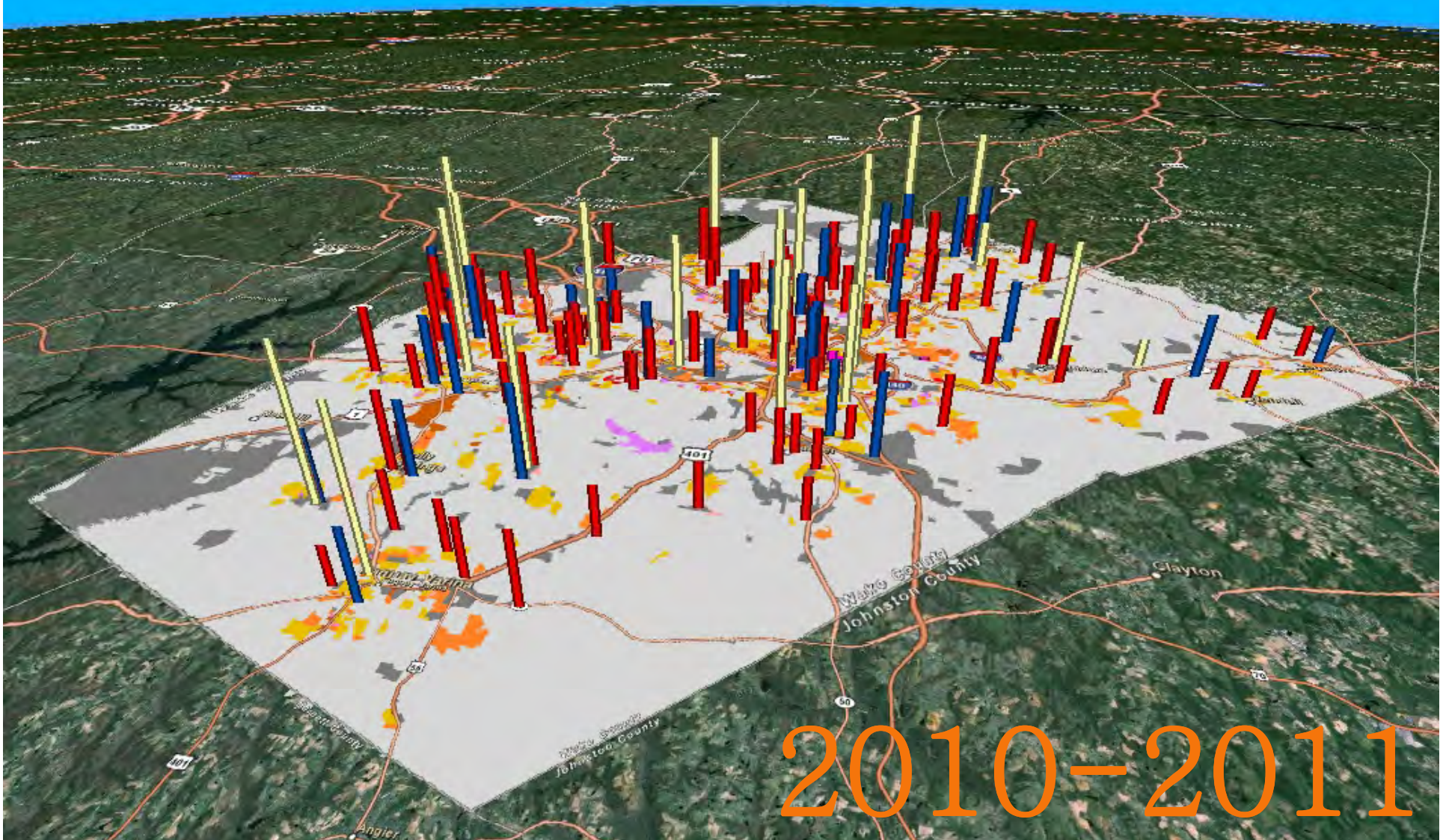

The Wake County Public School System School Statistics and Maps, 2010-2011 report was created to offer a snapshot of the current demographics in the Wake County Public School System through a data-driven and visually-pleasing manner. Information includes an overview, quick facts, individual school reports, student demographics, and enrollment projections. The majority of the data and maps included in the report represent summaries for the 2010-2011 school year. However, also included are enrollment projections until 2020, and the Capital Improvement Plan 2006 updates of data and maps that used to support the one billion building program approved by Wake County voters in 2006.
