

## 2007-08 Data Resources in QuickPlace

The following is not an exhaustive list of the data resources in QuickPlace, but it gives the location and description of the most commonly accessed reports that are available there.

To access your school's data in QuickPlace, go to <http://www2.wcpss.net/departments/testing> and click on the link that says "QuickPlace (password required)". Logins and passwords to access your school's information are distributed by the Testing Office to each Principal and each Testing Coordinator.

Type of Report	Folder where it can be found	Level at which data are reported	What the report tells you
Goal Summary report	In the folders for each specific test (e.g., "EOG 4th Grade Final Results", "Algebra I", etc.)	by teacher, by school	Gives a breakdown of the percent of EOG/EOC test items students answered correctly for each goal/objective in the NC Standard Course of Study. Also compares those class/school results to the results for students statewide.
Frequency report	In the folders for each specific test (e.g., "EOG 4th Grade Final Results", "Algebra I", etc.)	by teacher, by school	Gives the distribution of EOG and/or EOC scale scores and achievement levels for each teacher and for the entire school.
Class score rosters	In the folders for each specific test (e.g., "EOG 4th Grade Final Results", "Algebra I", etc.) and in the "Preliminary EOG Results" folder	by teacher	Lists the EOG, NCEXTEND2 and/or EOC test results for each tested student in the school. Includes scale scores as well as achievement levels for each student.
EOG summary results	In the "Preliminary EOG Results" folder <sup>1</sup>	by grade level, by school	Summarizes regular EOG results for the school for the current year compared to the prior year. Reports percentages of students scoring at or above Level III as well as average scale scores for each test.
EOC summary results	In the "School Wide Summaries" folder	by course	Summarizes EOC results for the school for the current year compared to the prior year and compared to system averages. Reports percentages of students scoring proficient as well as average scale scores for each test.
ABC reports	In the "ABC Results" folder	by school, by test, by course/subject, by grade, by subgroup	Summarizes growth and performance results under the state's ABCs accountability program. Reports growth and proficiency by grade, subject and course at the overall school level as well as for a variety of student subgroups within the school via charts and graphs.
Effectiveness Index <sup>1</sup>	In the "Effectiveness Index" folder	by school, by grade, by course/subject	Reports the relative performance of students in the school on EOG and EOC tests compared to other schools in WCPSS, taking into account the initial performance levels of students based on the prior year. See the interpretation document in the same folder for further information.
EOG/EOC Residual rosters <sup>1</sup>	In the "Effectiveness Index" folder	by teacher and class period	Reports "residuals" for individual students by class period as well as the class-wide average. Gives you a measure of the extent to which students in a given class underperformed or overperformed their expectation on EOC and EOG tests. See the interpretation document in the same folder for further information.
K-5 summary results	In the "K-5 Assessment Results" folder	by school, by subgroup	Reports the percentages of students proficient across the various reading, mathematics, and writing components of the K-5 assessment. Reports results for your school compared to the entire system.
2007-08 End-of-Year Rosters	In the "ABC Results" folder	by student	Gives you testing results (EOG, EOC, K-5, etc.) for each student in your school for 2007-08; allows for further individualized analysis of your own data.
2008-09 Student Rosters	Under "Student Lists", in the "Student Information 08-09" folder. (Elementary schools have a second version of this file under "Student Lists" with more detailed K-5 Assessment data).	by student	Gives you historical testing results (EOG, EOC, K-5, etc.) and other information on your current students as of Fall 2008; allows for further individualized analysis of your own data.
