GRANTS ADMINISTRATION ANNUAL SUMMARY REPORT: 2002-03

ABSTRACT

The Grants Administration and Compliance Reporting Office (GA) in the Wake County Public School System (WCPSS) was established in the 1985-86 school year. One hundred and sixty five grant applications were prepared in the 2002-03 school year; 121(73.3%) of the applications were awarded for approximately \$43.7 million. Although the majority of funds received were from federal government agencies, the greater part of the grant proposals (52.73%) and awards (48.76%) were with agencies other than government bodies. School-based grants constituted the bulk of the applications, with amounts ranging up to \$10,000. Most of the funds received (\$34.5 million) were secured through central office grant applications for school-based programs. The full report provides details on grant applications and awards for the 2002-03 year.

GRANTS ADMINISTRATION BACKGROUND

The Grants Administration and Compliance Reporting Office (GA) in the Wake County Public School System (WCPSS) was established in the 1985-86 school year, following a review of WCPSS finance and administrative functions conducted by Arthur Andersen & Company. One finding of the review was that a dedicated grant administrative function "...should be able to increase the monies made available to the WCPSS and avoid program mismanagement."

In 2002-03, compliance reporting functions were added as a responsibility of the Grant Administration Department, which works with various departments to ensure that data are collected, compiled, and reported in an accurate and timely manner to comply with federal and state reporting requirements.

RESPONSIBILITIES

A principle responsibility of the GA office is to secure public and private funding through entitlement and competitive grant opportunities in ways that are consistent with school district priorities, applicable regulations, and relevant research findings. This responsibility includes the following functions:

- Identify grant-funding opportunities and communicate these to WCPSS personnel.
- Advise the Board of Education of grant funding opportunities and secure approval to submit applications.
- Assist WCPSS personnel with preparing and submitting grant applications.
- Conduct training programs for WCPSS personnel on grant development and management.
- Interpret federal, state, and local rules and procedures governing grants.
- Monitor grant programs for compliance with program and statutory regulations and ensure compliance with federal and state data reporting requirements.
- Work with appropriate departments including: Information Systems Department, Human Resources Department, Curriculum and Instruction Department, Due Process Department, and Student Support Services Department to ensure that grant program data are collected, compiled, and reported in an accurate and timely manner to comply with federal and state reporting requirements.

PURPOSE OF ANNUAL REPORT

Every year, the GA office prepares a summary of grant development activities for the previous year. This report describes major accomplishments of the GA office along with systemwide grant development activities in the 2002-03 school year. The report enumerates the number and variety of grant applications submitted to various funding sources by central office personnel, school-based personnel, and others on behalf of WCPSS. Through this enumeration, the report is an account of the **effort** expended systemwide to prepare and submit grant applications, as well as the **success** with winning grant awards. The report is not a financial accounting of grants managed by WCPSS. The dollar amounts noted for individual grant applications and awards are based upon information collected from WCPSS Budget Department and figures reported to the GA office by groups and individuals submitting grant applications.

MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN 2002-03

- In the 2002-03 year, the Grants Administration office broke new ground as it worked with Instructional Services Department to develop a multi-million dollar application involving, several WCPSS schools, to the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction for the 21st Century Community Learning Centers discretionary grant program. The primary purpose of the grant program is to support academic achievement for at-risk students by providing extended learning opportunities for students. The WCPSS schools involved in this grant process were Brentwood Elementary School, Knightdale Elementary School, and three Garner schools (E. Garner Middle School, N. Garner Middle School and Garner Senior High School).

- Also, in 2002-03, Grants Administration worked with the Curriculum and Instruction Department to develop an application to the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction for the Refugee Children School Impact Grant.
- The GA Office continues to implement the Federal Personnel Activity Reporting System, monitoring employees' time and effort, documenting 529 employees with salaries funded in whole or part with federal funds in the spring 2002-03 year.

Figure 1 demonstrates that the greatest number of grant applications submitted to any single funding source by schools was 36 applications submitted to Wake Education Partnership, out of which 32 grant applications were awarded totaling approximately \$62,000.

Number of Applications to Wake Education Partnership

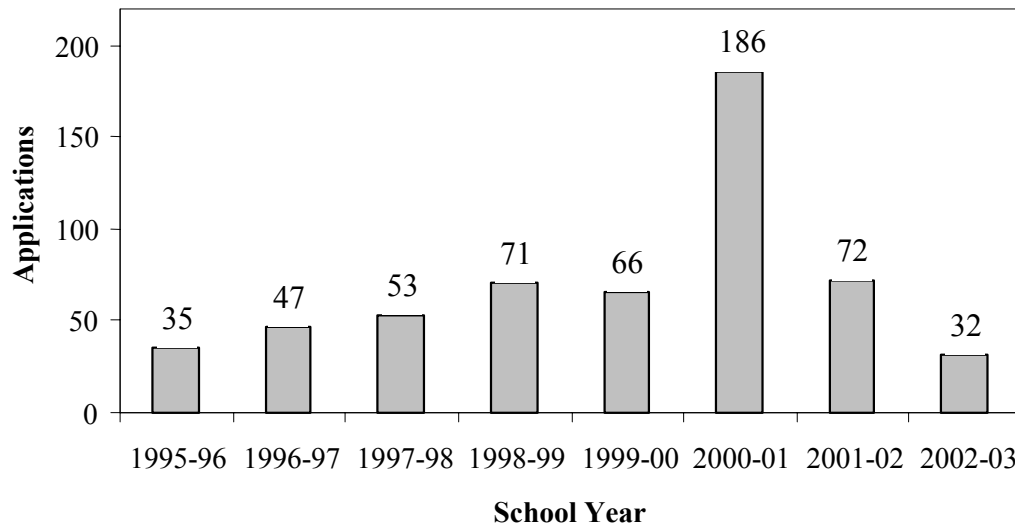

- ⁽³⁾ "Funding level of proposals awarded," reflects only the amount received in the single year, which can include new programs.

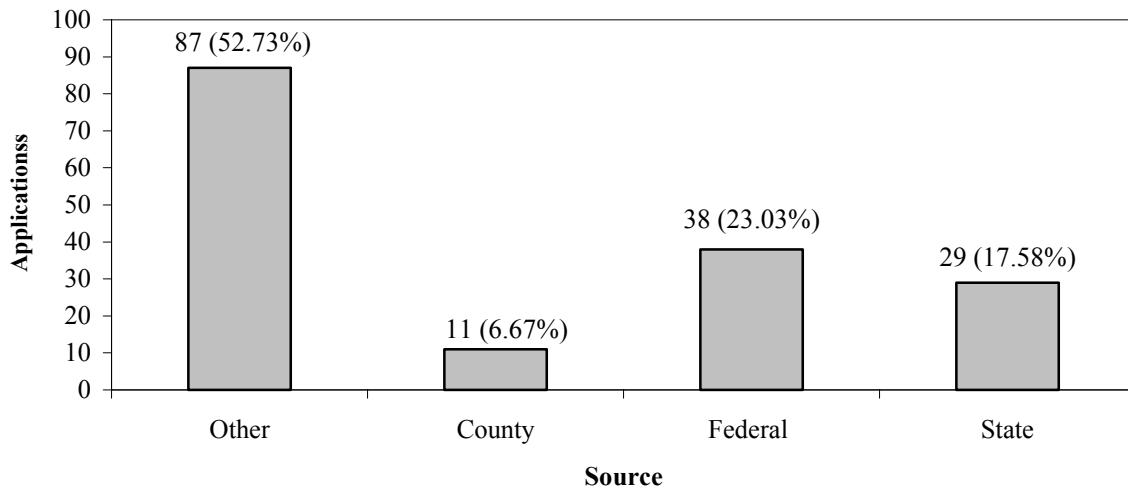

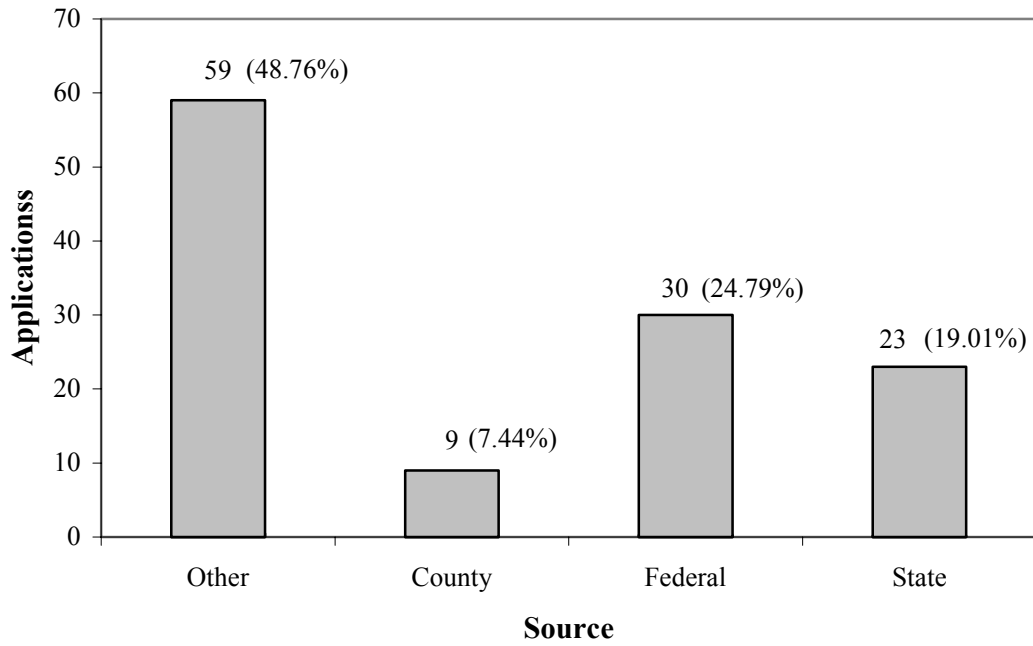
Figure 2 demonstrates that the majority of grant proposals (52.73%) were submitted to agencies other than governmental bodies, including community foundations, corporations, and professionals associations (e.g., Wake Education Partnership, North Carolina Electric Cooperatives, North Carolina Arts Council, National Science Teachers Association).

Number of Proposals Submitted by Funding Source (n = 165)**



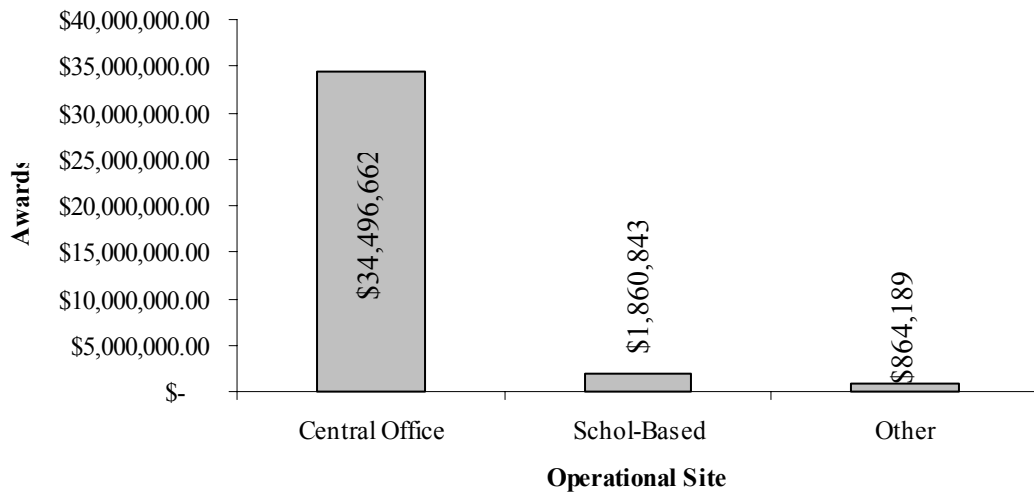
Consistent with the information depicted in Figure 2, Figure 3 indicates that the majority of grant awards (48.76%) were received from agencies other than governmental bodies. Most of the grant awards from "Other" agencies are school-based grants for relatively small amounts of money.

Most grant applications are prepared and received by school-based personnel. However, grant funds received by the district are overwhelmingly secured through central office-based grants (see Figure 4). Federal entitlement grants account for most of the grant funds received by the school district.

SCHOOL GRANTS CONTACT PROGRAM

The School Grants Contact (SGC) program encourages each school to identify one staff member to serve as a liaison with the GA office. The main responsibilities of the SGC are to receive communications from the GA office about grant opportunities, distribute this information to school staff, and advise school staff of district policies and procedures pertaining to the submission of grant applications. Those with the interest often assume lead roles at their school with assisting school staff to prepare grant applications

SGC meetings are conducted for the purpose of sharing specific information about pending grant opportunities. Historically, these meetings have been conducted after regular school hours at a central location, and attendance has typically ranged between 5-10 individuals per meeting. In the 2002-03 school year, meetings were held bi-annually at the Webster Center and one-on-one training was also provided.

With SGC participation being relatively small, considerations for the 2003-04 school year are to provide one-on-one training upon request at the convenience of the School Grant Contact, to make greater use of email distributions to the SGCs, and to continue the promotion of the Grants Administration intranet web site.
