

Summary Information For Growth Management Planning

Prepared By The Growth and Planning Department

November 15, 2006

Staff in the WCPSS Growth and Planning Department are currently engaged in developing a growth management plan for the 2007-08 school year and preliminary plans for the 2008-09 and 2009-10 school years. Plans are based upon enrollment projections jointly developed with the Wake County Planning Department and capital improvement programs (CIPs) that were adopted by the Board of Education in 2004 and May 2006.

The primary objective of growth management planning is to provide appropriate environments for teaching and learning for all students by accommodating growth, minimizing the impact of overcrowding and assigning a healthy student population to every school.

Major challenges being addressed for the 2007-08 school year include:

1. Assigning students to five new schools

2. Adjusting base areas where necessary for existing year-round schools that will lose application areas to schools changing from a traditional calendar to a year-round calendar

3. Reducing the base areas of high growth elementary and middle schools where possible in order to avoid overcrowding that interferes with teaching and learning.

The next page in this document shows the planned schedule for opening of new schools based upon the current CIP. The plan may need to change if enrollment growth differs significantly from the projections used to develop the plan.

Subsequent pages present data on all WCPSS schools in tabular format. The data shows the membership (number of students) in each school as of the 20th day of the current school year, the number of mobile or modular classrooms at the school, the level of crowding in the school (a

ratio of membership to capacity including mobile or modular classrooms) and two demographic descriptors of the student population in the school. Percent Low SES (socio-economic status) is an estimate of the percentage of students from low-income families based upon participation in the federal lunch program. Percent LEP is the percentage of students identified as having limited English proficiency. Note that some LEP students are enrolled in special English as a Second Language (ESL) classes and some are not, based upon their level of proficiency.

Another set of data describes the base area assigned to each school. Students within the base area attend the assigned school unless they apply and are admitted to a magnet school or a year-round school that is different than the assigned school. The percentage of students attending the base school, magnet schools, or year-round schools will not add to 100% because some students attend schools other than the base school through transfer requests or special placements based upon the needs of the students. The one-year and three-year changes in the number of students are calculated using grades K-5 for elementary schools, 6-8 for middle schools, 9-12 for high schools. Counts of students by area are compiled each October by the Growth and Planning Department.

The fastest growing school base areas are shown below. Some of this growth will be addressed through the opening of new schools. Some of the growth will be addressed through the change from a traditional to a year-round calendar for 19 elementary schools and 3 middle schools. Some of the growth will need to be addressed through reassignment of areas from more crowded schools to less crowded schools.
