**Social Skills Lesson Plan Form**  
**Expectation: Give Respect**

<b>Skill/Concept:</b> Respect-What is respect? How to we give respect?
<b>Context:</b> Teaching in the classroom about how to give respect school-wide
<b>Introduction:</b> "Dramatic scene" Teachers present a staged example of "disrespect"
<b>Teacher Model:</b> Do over of dramatic scene demonstrating respect, the right way
<b>Role Play:</b> Example – Small group – receives or creates a scenario card and then presents a 5 minute "quick skit" demonstrating a scene from card  Non-example- one or two of the cards are non-examples. After the presentation of the non-example, students answer question: "What would students choose to do differently that was respectful?" They could reenact the scene choosing respectful behavior.
<b>Review:</b> 2 column list of behaviors in school that demonstrate respect/disrespect
<b>Practice Throughout the Day:</b> Ask students, "Does that look respectful to you?" in various school situations (find both examples and non examples). Point out situations that demonstrate respect in settings and review concepts in all classes throughout day.
<b>Homework Ideas:</b> Look for situations at school where your teachers and peers are Giving Respect and verbally report them to class the next day!  No homework, if students demonstrate respect!  Think of a situation where you did not give respect, and re-write the story to demonstrate what you could have done to demonstrate respect.  Develop more scenario cards on "Give Respect" and we can act them out periodically in future.
