

## PBS Training Opportunities

Training Length	Training Title	Training Description
<b>2-3 Hours</b>	Classroom Management	This course will aid educators in creating a classroom management plan by incorporating the principles of Positive Behavior Support.
<b>1-2 Hours</b>	Secondary Interventions	The secondary interventions training will provide intensive or targeted interventions to support students who are still struggling with primary prevention efforts
<b>1-2 Hours</b>	Tertiary Interventions	The tertiary Interventions training is designed to focus on the needs of individuals who exhibited patterns of problem behavior who are still struggling with primary or secondary interventions.
<b>1-2 Hours</b>	Relationship Building	This course will help all educators build and maintain relationships with parents, students, and colleagues.
<b>30 Minutes</b>	Parents & PBS	This presentation provides parents with an overview of Positive Behavior Support concepts and implementation along with suggestions on how to teach and manage their child's behavior based on PBS principles.
<b>1 1/2 -2 Hours</b>	Teacher Assistants Classroom Management	This course will focus on assisting T.A.s with classroom management strategies, correcting and encouraging desired behavior, building relationships with students and strategies for dealing with difficult students
<b>30 Minutes</b>	PBS Overview for School Staff	This training will provide the school staff with a general overview of Positive Behavior Support. Some topics covered include guiding principles and features of PBS, roles of the PBS team, and a brief summary of all three training modules.
<b>1-2 Hours</b>	Basics of Behavior	This training will orient staff to the origins and motivators for understanding student behaviors. As we attempt to foster paradigm shifts in how schools assess and determine student functions of behaviors, this training will serve as a springboard for the more intense discussions for secondary and tertiary interventions.
<b>2-4 Hours</b>	Year Two/Three Contact Meetings	The year two/three contact meeting is intended for schools that are in the second or third year of PBS implementation. This half day workshop will focus on building sustainable change, dealing with students who exhibit at-risk behaviors, reinforcing appropriate behaviors, as well as ways of increasing faculty involvement.
<b>3 Hours</b>	SWIS	This comprehensive training will equip school based PBS teams to access behavior referral data via the School Wide Information System (SWIS). PBS schools strive toward data based decision making and fidelity of school-wide implementation of universals. SWIS is a powerful web-based tool that aligns with PBS. Upon completing the training, participants will be able to navigate the SWIS system.
<b>1-2 Hours</b>	Understanding and Managing Conflict	This training will focus on learning the causes of conflict and the role adults have in preventing and managing escalating behavior. We will explore the conflict cycle and learn how to intervene, as well as the phases of conflict with strategies for de-escalation of each phase.
