As a quality control measure, participation in each module will be limited. Participation will be determined on a first registration received basis. We reserve the right to cancel a session due to weather conditions or lack of registration. In the event it is necessary to cancel a session, participants will receive a full refund of registration fees.

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Modules 1 - 4 will follow the same time schedule:

Day 1: 8:30 am-4:00 pm and Day 2: 8:30 am-1:00 pm.

Participants must attend the entire session to receive credit for the session.

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There will be a \$125 registration fee for each module. A participant may register for each module or register for the entire 4 modular series. (Registration received after the established *Received By Date* will be charged a \$25 late fee.)

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A *Certificate of Credit* will be issued upon completion of the series. Individual session credit will be issued upon special request. A participant will be issued one certificate at no cost. Replacement of previously issued certificates will be charged a \$25 replacement fee per certificate issued.

Introduction for Modules 5 - 8

Modules 5 – 7 will cover program area specific topics related to Career and Technical Student Organizations (HOSA), work-based learning, and legal considerations (i.e. Perkins IV, public school law, etc.) The registration fee for Modules 5 – 7 is \$375. Module 8 will be completed during the 2008 Career and Technical Education Summer Conference. The registration fee for Module 8 is \$100.

Participants must attend the entire session to receive credit for the session.

A *Certificate of Credit* will be issued upon completion of the series. Individual session credit will be issued upon special request. A participant will be issued one certificate at no cost. Replacement of previously issued certificates will be charged a \$25 replacement fee per certificate issued.
