

FREE TAX HELP & e-file

Puzzled by the tax law or which credits and deductions to take? Need assistance with your tax return?

You may want to visit us at Williams High School.

We are certified volunteers from Williams High School Academy of Finance sponsored by State Farm and have been trained to prepare basic tax returns (1040A, 1040EZ and 1040 w/std deduction). The IRS Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program offers free tax help to low- to moderate-income (generally, \$40,000 and below) people who cannot prepare their own tax returns.

What to bring:

- Proof of identification (a photo ID).
- Social security cards or ITIN numbers for you, your spouse & dependents (Free Spanish translation)
- Birth dates for you, spouse, and dependents.
- A copy of last year's Federal & State tax returns (if available)
- Current year's tax package (if you received one)
- Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, SSA-1099 from all employers
- Interest and dividend statements from banks (Forms 1099)
- Bank Routing & Account Numbers for Direct Deposit
- Other information about income and expenses
- Total Paid for Day Care and Day Care provider's ID#
- To e-file a married filing joint tax return, both spouses must be present.

We will Prepare:

- 1040EZ, 1040A, 1040V, 1040ES
- 1040 (A, B, C-EZ, EIC, R, SE)
- 2441 (Child Credit)
- 8812 (Additional Child Credit)
- 8863 (Education Credit)

We will NOT prepare:

- Schedule C or E
- Complicated Schedule D
- SS-5 (SSN Request)
- 2106 (Employee Business Expense)
- 3903 (Moving)
- 8606 (Nondeductible IRA)
- 8615 (Minor's Investment Income)
