- _____ 12. Put on gloves.
- _____ 13. Remove old dressing, if present, and discard in biohazard bag. Observe condition of wound or skin.
- _____ 14. Pick up corner of new dressing and place untouched side of dressing directly on area to be dressed.
- _____ 15. Secure dressing with tape or bandage wrap as needed.
- _____ 16. Remove gloves and wash hands.
- _____ 17. Provide for comfort with call signal in reach.
- _____ 18. Dispose of biohazard bag.
- _____ 19. Record actions and report any abnormal observations to supervisor.
