Call for Model Lessons

2008 CTE Summer Conference

FACS teachers will again have the opportunity to share model lessons at the 2008 CTE Summer Conference in Greensboro on Wednesday afternoon, July 23, 2008. FACS model lessons are mini-lessons that allow FACS teachers to observe teaching styles in action.

Each model lesson will be presented within a 25-minute time slot. The recommended length of model lessons is 15 to 20 minutes, leaving 5 to 10 minutes for questions and discussion. The topic of the lesson may be any FACS-related topic. Half of teachers who attend model lessons will role play either middle or high school students and participate as learners in the model lesson. The other half of attendees will serve as observers of the lesson. The presenter serves as the teacher and teaches just as he/she would teach his/her own students. The goal is to provide at least 20 different model lessons so that each person attending summer conference will be able to attend two model lessons. Each presenter will present only one time.

Handouts will be copied onto a CD for all teachers attending Summer Conference and hard copies will be reproduced for the lesson presentation. Anyone who does not meet this deadline will need to prepare 55 copies of each handout used.
