How to sign up

via Yahoo!Groups

- NCBETeachers: For Business Education teachers
- NCFACSteachers: For Family and Consumer Sciences teachers
- NCHOETeachers: For Health Occupations teachers

To sign up for any of these groups, go to <http://groups.yahoo.com/group/xxxxx> where xxxxx is the name of the group (for example, Business Teachers go to <http://groups.yahoo.com/group/NCBETeachers>). Click on Subscribe (bottom right of screen). If you already have a Yahoo!Groups ID and password, sign in. You will get instructions about how to proceed. If you are not already a Yahoo!Groups member, click on the [Click Here to Register for FREE](#) link. This will take you through the steps of joining Yahoo and then help you sign up for the specific group in which you are interested. Please keep track of your Yahoo!Groups ID and password for later use.

If you have filtering software that does not allow you to go to the Yahoo!Groups site, you can send a blank email message to NCBETeachers-subscribe@yahogroups.com, NCFACSteachers-subscribe@yahogroups.com, or NCHOETeachers-subscribe@yahogroups.com. You will be subscribed automatically.
