Welcome to the new school year!

We would like to ask that you fill out a new Walker Info Form for the new year. Please be sure to include the name of anyone that you authorize to pick up your child as a walker in the case you are not personally available to meet your child. Please know that these other adults may be asked to show ID if they are not known to staff members. Please keep this letter for your information.

*Kindergarteners and 1st graders must have an adult (or another responsible person) to pick them up. Kindergarten students will exit via the main school entrance.

*Please meet and pick up your child (Kindergarten students should be picked up at the main entrance) under the picnic shelter located near the bus loop. 1st-5th grade students will exit via the side door nearest the pre-k playground.

*At 2:20, walkers will be released to meet their parents or walk home. All walkers must be picked up by 2:25.

*We do NOT send students over to WLMS to get in carpool. This does not meet the definition as a walker from our campus.

*Parking in a parking lot or across from the school and walking to get your child does not meet the definition as a walker from our campus.

*The principal reserves the right to revoke walker privileges if walker guidelines are not followed.

Thanks in advance for your compliance! We want everyone to get home safely at the end of the day.
