

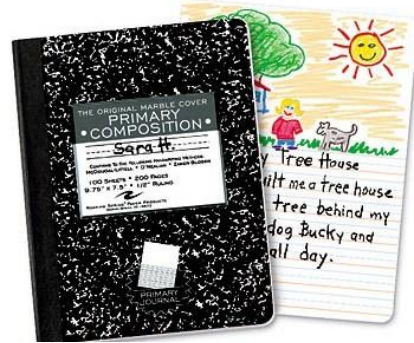
# Carpenter Kindergarten Supply List

1 package of Crayola Twistables crayons (24 count)

- These are pricier than traditional crayons but are so durable that they will last the entire school year!
