Homework Policy

At Root Elementary, we define the term "homework" as school-related instruction that is to be completed outside the classroom. It should fulfill the following purposes:

- 1. Enrich and extend school experiences through related home activities.
- 2. Reinforce learning by providing practice and application.
- 3. Stimulate effort, independence, responsibility, and self-direction.

The following are school-wide expectations for homework:

- 1. Homework will provide practice to reinforce skills learned in class.
- 2. Homework will provide a daily opportunity for parents to encourage their children to succeed in school.
- 3. All homework assignments will be completed on time.
- 4. Students will turn in work that is neatly done.
- 5. All assignments will be evaluated for understanding and results shared with students in oral or written form by the teacher. Homework will not be assigned a grade
- 6. It is important that homework be individualized and differentiated to challenge all students.
- 7. Homework will only be assigned Monday through Thursday.

Homework Times for Grades K-5

Kindergarten: 20 minutes per night *including* 10 minutes of reading. (10 minutes of written homework)

Grade 1: 20 minutes per night *including* 10 minutes of reading. (10 minutes of written homework)

Grade 2: 20 minutes per night *including* 10 minutes of reading. (10 minutes of written homework)

Grade 3: 50 minutes per night *including* 20 minutes of reading. (30 minutes of written homework)

Grade 4: 50 minutes per night *including* 20 minutes of reading. (30 minutes of written homework)

Grade 5: 50 minutes per night *including* 20-30 minutes of reading. (20-30 minutes of written homework)

These guidelines represent the maximum amount of nightly homework, however teachers/grade levels may opt to not give written homework on a nightly basis.
