

## Carpool Information Maintaining a safe environment for all children and adults during AM and PM carpool is our #1 priority!

## **General Information**

- \*Please adhere to the School Zone 25 mph speed limit.
- \*Always go to the end of the carpool line.
- \*Please refrain from using cell phones once in the carpool line.
- \*Please remain in your vehicle at all times.
- \* Please keep your vehicle in the carpool line along the curb.
- \*There is a parking lot around back that can be used if needed.
- \*There is no passing once in the carpool loop.

## **Morning Carpool**

- \*Students should not be dropped off before 7:15 am unless they are on a.m. safety patrol.
- \*Please arrive in carpool in time for your child to be in class, ready to learn, by 7:45.
- \*Morning carpool is a continuous flow, please pull up to let your child out of the car.
- \*Staff begin instruction at 7:45 and no longer supervise carpool arrival. Children can no longer be dropped off at that time. You will need to come to the office to sign your child into school.
- \*Please DO NOT drop your children off or park along Forest Pines Drive.

## Afternoon Carpool

- \*Children will be dismissed from a central location and supervised by staff members.
- \*If you need to pick up your child early, please do this prior to 2:00 pm to avoid confusion during the busy 2:15 dismissal.
- \*Parking a vehicle and then walking to pick up a student is not permitted.
- \*Remember to display your carpool number on your rearview mirror and keep it displayed until your child is loaded. To maintain student security, if you do not have your carpool number displayed, you may be asked to go to the front office and show picture ID in order to get your child.
- \*If you are taking home children other than your own, you will need to have all corresponding carpool numbers displayed.
- \*Once your child(ren) are loaded please do not pull out of the carpool line. We want to ensure the safety of all NFP Falcon families.
