



EXPLANATION AND TERMS OF AGREEMENT REGARDING BYOD AT LIGON GT MAGNET MIDDLE SCHOOL

The purpose of this document is to inform parents, guardians, and students of the rules governing the use of personally owned electronic devices while on or near school property.

BYOD promotes the use of digital technology within the classroom by supplementing school resources with student owned devices.

Ligon MS defines “devices” as privately owned wireless and portable electronic items that can be used for wireless internet access, word processing, image/video capturing, sound recording, and information transmitting.

Students unable to bring their own devices to school will have access to school technology.

Ligon GT Magnet Middle School and its staff are not liable for any device that is stolen or damaged. Securing the device is solely the responsibility of the individual owner.

Students and parents participating in BYOD must adhere to the Student Code of Conduct, and the Acceptable Use Policy found in the Student Handbook.
