BYOD Teachers

Better understanding of appropriate uses of technology (right technology-right time-right learner)

Increased use of student centered learning strategies

Increased use of technology-based instructional resources in the classroom

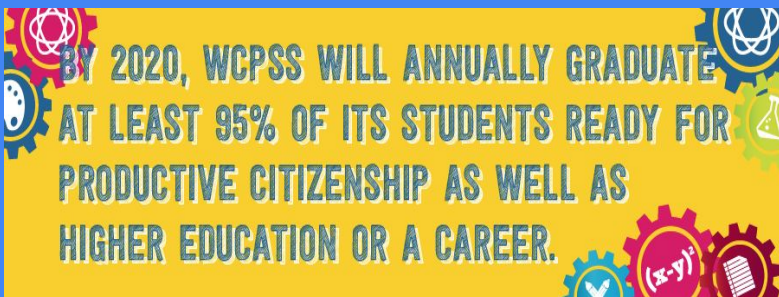
Increased confidence in ability to *facilitate and activate* student learning

More frequent use of data and collaboration with peers to make adjustments to their teaching

Become tool and resource agnostic

Promote effective communication and collaboration among colleagues, staff, parents, and students using digital tools

Long Term Outcomes

Increased engagement and collaboration among BYOD leadership, teachers, parents and the community

BYOD programs serve as a bridge between students' in-school and out-of-school learning

Schools become progressive learning environments that strategically integrate digital resources and emerging technologies

Teachers improve instructional practice around designing, developing and implementing digital learning experiences

Students are ready for productive citizenship, as well as college and career

95%+ graduation rate by 2020

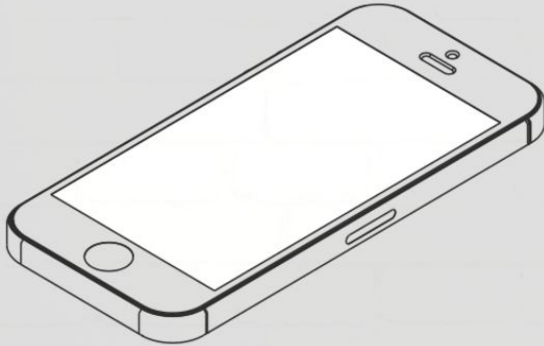

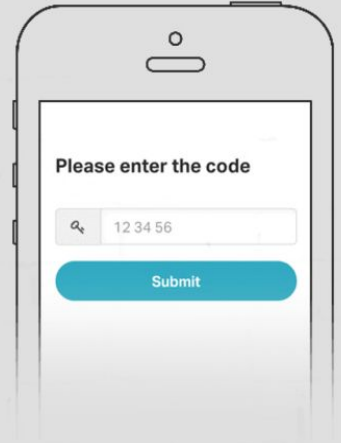
