

Students and parents/guardians participating in BYOD must adhere to the Student Code of Conduct, as well as all Board policies, particularly WCPSS Student Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) 3225. Furthermore, the students and parents/guardians must agree to the following conditions.

		We understand that the student takes full responsibility for his or her device, and the school and staff are not responsible for the security and safety of the student owned device.
		We understand that the device must be in silent mode when not in academic use while on school campus and while riding a school bus.
		We understand that the device may not be used to commit academic dishonesty on assignments or tests or for non-instructional purposes.
		We understand that the student must have and utilize the WCPSS Wake ID and access only content on the device which is relevant to the curriculum and follow all Hilburn BYOD policies and procedures.
		We understand that the student must comply with teachers' or staff's requests to shutdown the device, as teachers/staff will not touch the device. The student will not touch any other student's device.
		We understand that the school's network filters will be applied to the internet connection, and the student will not attempt to bypass them.
		We understand that any attempt by the student to bring on premises or infect the network with a Virus, Trojan, or program designed to damage, alter, destroy, or provide access to unauthorized data or information is in violation of the AUP policy and will result in disciplinary actions.
		We understand that processing or accessing information on school property related to "hacking", altering, or bypassing network security policies is in violation of the AUP policy and will result in disciplinary actions.
		We understand that devices are expected to be charged at home and put away if the battery loses its charge. If a student forgets their device at home it may not be brought to the school to be delivered to the student.
		We understand that student printing from personal devices will not be possible at school, and while at school, all devices will utilize the WCPSS BYOD wifi.

I understand and will abide by the above guidelines. I further understand that any violation is unethical and may result in the loss of my network and/or device privileges as well as other disciplinary action.
