## FINE ARTS COURSES

| Beginning Band (Woodwinds) <br> 18 Weeks $=($ Semester $)$ | 52862 YOAW | Emphasizes the acquisition of basic musical skills. No previous musical experience is required. Several musical <br> selections are performed for an audience. A few evening performances should be anticipated. Students may <br> begin on flute or clarinet and will have an opportunity to transition to other instruments later in the school year. <br> Initially, classes are divided between brass instruments and woodwind instruments. |

| Beginning Band (Brass) <br> 18 Weeks $=($ Semester $)$ | 52862 YOAB | Emphasizes the acquisition of basic musical skills. No previous musical experience is required. Several musical <br> selections are performed for an audience. A few evening performances should be anticipated. Students may <br> begin on trumpet or trombone and will have an opportunity to transition to other instruments later in the school <br> year. Initially, classes are divided between brass instruments and woodwind instruments. |

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| Music Exploratory <br> 9 Weeks = (Quarter) | 52092 YOK | Students are introduced to the skills necessary for singing and playing music with accuracy and expression while <br> interpreting the sound and symbols of music. Through the study of various genres and cultures, students will <br> analyze, evaluate, and understand the music and concepts from other areas. |

| Chorus <br> 18 Weeks = (Semester) | $52692 Y 0 D$ | Students are introduced to the skills necessary for singing with accuracy and expression while interpreting the <br> sound and symbols of music. Students learn how to use traditional notation to learn music, and to respond <br> correctly to conductors' gestures both in rehearsal and public performance. Students will study vocal music and its <br> relationship to other cultures, eras, and geographical locations. Students in this class should anticipate evening <br> performances. |
| Visual Arts Exploratory <br> 9 Weeks = (Quarter) | $54092 Y 0 L$ | Learn about the elements and principles of art through creating two-dimensional artwork such as <br> drawing, painting, mixed-media, and printmaking. Explore various cultures and art history. |

## WORLD LANGUANGES COURSES

| Exploratory Language <br> 9 Weeks = (Quarter) | 12752Y0 | An introduction to the Spanish language and culture. Students will explore Spanish vocabulary and structures to communicate using short, memorized phrases. Topics include introduction, greetings, and biographical information. This course is not included in the curriculum series for high school credit. |
