- **Students usually remain at Phillips HS until graduation**

Student Profile

- Student is failing or at-risk of failing several credits
- Student is able to be redirected by teachers and administrators within the traditional setting
- Student has demonstrated a history of building positive relationships with teachers in the referring school setting
- Student has a desire to “catch up” (22 credits are needed to graduate)
- When/If discipline issues occur, they are most frequently observed in larger, less structured times/area of the school
- Student may need flexible scheduling options (including evening program)
- No history of severe or aggressive acting out, or behaviors requiring significant restrictive programming
- Student has limited access to additional support services within the referring school
- Student has demonstrated a positive response to smaller environments (if available) within the traditional setting
- Student may have extenuating life circumstances (homelessness, pregnancy, medical condition, etc.)

Transportation

All students are transported to Phillips HS through Enloe HS magnet transportation.

Dress Code

All students must dress according to the school dress code each day.

- Tan or Black pants, shorts, or skirts
 - Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than two inches above the knee
 - Pants must be worn at the waist
- All tops must be black, white, or gray.
 - Short or long sleeves, sleeveless is not permitted
- Shoes must be appropriate for all planned activities at school.
