- Students usually remain at Phillips HS until graduation

## Student Profile

- Student is often failing or at-risk of failing several HS credits.
- □ Student can be redirected by teachers and administrators within the traditional setting.
- Student has demonstrated a history of building positive relationships with teachers in the referring school setting.
- □ Student has a desire to "catch up" (22 credits are needed to graduate for all students).
- When/If discipline issues occur, they are most frequently observed in larger, less structured times/area of the school.
- No history of severe or aggressive acting out, or behaviors requiring significant restrictive programming.
- Student has demonstrated a positive response to smaller environments (if available) within the traditional setting.

## Transportation

All students who ride buses are transported to Phillips HS through Enloe HS magnet transportation.

#### **Application Process**

All students should work with their counselor at their base WCPSS High School to complete an application for admission.

#### Dress Code

All students must follow the WCPSS dress code.
