---

- Referrals **MUST** come from current WCPSS HS (exception for Mt. Vernon MS)
- Students may be eligible for sports at their base HS.

- Regular Incentive Programs
- Daily Enrichment Hour Available after school
- 22 credits are required for graduation.
- **Students usually remain at Phillips HS until graduation**

## Student Profile

---

- ☐ Student is often failing or at-risk of failing several HS credits.
- ☐ Student can be redirected by teachers and administrators within the traditional setting.
- ☐ Student has demonstrated a history of building positive relationships with teachers in the referring school setting.
- ☐ Student has a desire to “catch up” (22 credits are needed to graduate for all students).
- ☐ When/If discipline issues occur, they are most frequently observed in larger, less structured times/area of the school.
- ☐ No history of severe or aggressive acting out, or behaviors requiring significant restrictive programming.
- ☐ Student has demonstrated a positive response to smaller environments (if available) within the traditional setting.

## Transportation

---

All students who ride buses are transported to Phillips HS through Enloe HS magnet transportation.

## Application Process

---

All students should work with their counselor at their base WCPSS High School to complete an application for admission.

## Dress Code

---

All students must follow the WCPSS dress code.
