Graduation Rehearsal

Graduation Rehearsal: June 3, 2020 (12:45pm-3:00pm)

You should be seated in your assigned seat no later than 12:45pm dressed in regular school clothes. Attendance at our Graduation Rehearsal is **MANDATORY** to participate in the final commencement ceremony on June 10. Tardiness will not be tolerated; therefore, plan to be at the Raleigh Convention Center early. It is recommended that you carpool because the City of Raleigh charges for parking in the adjacent parking decks, and you should plan to pay when you exit the garage.

Students will receive 7 tickets for the graduation ceremony when they walk across the stage at graduation rehearsal. Extra tickets will be distributed through a lottery system; information about the lottery system will be discussed at the first Senior Meeting on April 29. Students needing extra tickets can also make arrangements with classmates who are not planning to use all of their tickets. Tickets are free; make sure you do not pay for extra tickets.

CHANGES TO SENIOR HONOR DESIGNATIONS

The way Wake County Public Schools recognize top high school seniors changed. Starting last year, seniors were recognized under the new Latin honors system, which is modeled on how college and universities recognize top-achieving graduates. Under the new system, seniors were recognized with the following honors based on their GPA:

- Summa Cum Laude weighted GPA of 4.25 or higher
- Magna Cum Laude weighted GPA of 4.0 to 4.249
- Cum Laude weighted GPA of 3.75 to 3.99

With this update in effect, Millbrook High School made changes to the Graduation Attire and selection process for Graduation speakers. Below will outline the information for both changes.

Appropriate Dress:

Changes to Official Dress for Senior Assembly and Graduation:

- Senior cap and gown attire now has FOUR parts:
 - 1. Gown
 - 2. Cap
 - 3. Tassel
 - 4. (NEW) Stole Every stole will have the Millbrook Crest printed on the right hand side. Earned Latin honors will be printed on the left hand side.

The Official Dress should ONLY be worn for the Senior Assembly and Graduation. If you lose your cap or stole or tassel see Mrs. Davis. There will be a fee to replace these items.


Senior Assembly & Graduation Honors Attire:

- Senior Assembly Wear any cords or pins from Millbrook sponsored clubs and organizations.
- *NEW Updates* Graduation Ceremony (at Convention Center) ONLY allowed to wear NHS pin, IB Diploma Programme pin, and/or DMCA pin. Pins should be placed on the left-hand side of the stole, in the area opposite from the Millbrook Crest, or pinned directly above recognized Latin honors.

Additionally, under the cap and gown, students have two options for dress:

- 1. LADIES: Simple dress or skirt/top (No maxi-dresses/maxi-skirts. It should not be seen hanging below the graduation gown.) OR Dark dress pants (navy/black/charcoal, NOT brown) and a dress top/blouse. Either way nothing should show in the open neck area whether you wear a dress or pants. Dress-shoes should be plain (no embellishments), closed toe, and black.
- 2. GENTLEMEN: Solid white dress-shirt and a dark tie. Dark dress pants (navy, black, charcoal, NOT brown) should be worn. Dress-shoes should be plain (no embellishments), closed toe, and black.
- NO jeans, leggings, or cargo pants allowed.
- Absolutely NO purses under gowns.
- Absolutely NO cell phones. Leave your cell phones, keys, purses, etc. with your family members.

Inappropriate attire of any type at the Senior Assembly and Graduation ceremony WILL NOT be tolerated. Anyone dressed inappropriately WILL NOT participate in senior activities. If you have a problem obtaining the appropriate attire please let your counselor know.



Senior Speaker Auditions (2019-2020)

Senior Assembly Speaking Roles:

- 1. Introduction of Principal Reads a prepared introduction about Mrs. King.
- 2. Introduction of Speaker Reads a prepared introduction about the Senior Speaker.
- 3. **Senior Speaker WRITES and reads an original 1-1.5 minute speech for the senior class.

Graduation Speaking Roles:

- 1. Opening of Graduation Ceremony Opens our Graduation Ceremony by reading Pledge of Allegiance and introducing our Special Guests and introducing our Senior Class President.
- 2. **The Millbrook Charge Speech AND Introduction of Principal WRITES and reads an original 1-1.5 minute speech at graduation that is a charge (go out and conquer the world) to the Senior Class. Also, reads a prepared introduction about Mrs. King.

**If you are auditioning for "Senior Assembly: Senior Speaker" OR "Graduation: The Millbrook Charge Speech" please prepare/write a 30 second sample of the speech you would like to give as that speaker. You may bring a written copy; there is no need to memorize your speech.
