

Volunteer Opportunities & Directions

These opportunities offer various ways to get involved and make a positive impact on our students and school community. We would love to have you join us in supporting our students!

Reading Tutoring

- **Description:** Provide structured, one-on-one tutoring for 2nd-5th grade students to improve reading fluency, confidence, and accelerate learning. Volunteers will use the evidence-based HELPS curriculum, designed to offer targeted reading support. Learn more: https://www.wakeed.org/waketogether/
- Time Commitment: At least one hour per week.
- **Training:** A virtual training will be provided. To sign up, please fill out the Lynn Road Elementary Tutor Interest Form and be assigned to Lynn Road through WakeTogether.

Math Tutoring

- **Description:** Help students in 1st-5th grade strengthen their math skills through small group tutoring (2-4 students) using Elevation Station Math Games. The resource provides all necessary materials, including questions to guide the tutoring process, making it suitable even for those without a strong math background.
- Time Commitment: At least one hour per week.
- Training: A brief training will be provided to get you started.

Mentoring

- **Description:** Build meaningful, one-on-one relationships with students by mentoring them through activities like sharing lunch, reading together, or simply spending time. Mentoring helps foster trust and supports students' emotional and academic growth.
- Time Commitment: Weekly visits for consistency are encouraged.

Media Center Support

- Description: Assist the media specialist with various tasks such as sorting and organizing books, checking out books for students, labeling new resources, and helping keep the library running smoothly.
- Time Commitment: Flexible, based on your availability.

Donation Center

- **Description:** Help sort and organize donations for our school's food pantry, which supports students and families facing food insecurity. Volunteers will be contacted by the Social Worker as needs arise.
- Time Commitment: As needed, based on donation availability.

Parent Teacher Association (PTA)

- **Description:** Collaborate with other families to support school activities such as organizing Staff Appreciation Week, helping with Field Day, setting up and cleaning up for family events, assisting with the Yearbook, and contributing to various school-wide projects that enhance the student and staff experience.
- Time Commitment: As needed and flexible based on your availability.

Steps to Become a Volunteer:

Step 1: WCPSS Volunteer Registration

All volunteers must first register with the Wake County Public School System (WCPSS). This registration process is required to ensure that all volunteers meet district safety standards, including criminal history and sexual offender registry checks, and comply with WCPSS Board Policy 5020: Visitors to the School.

To register, follow these steps:

- 1. Visit the WCPSS MyVolunteer system:

- 2. Complete the disclosure and authorization forms.
- 3. Review the WCPSS Volunteer Agreement and the Fair Credit Reporting Act summary.
- 4. Submit the requested information.

Once you've registered, the district will review your application. After approval, you'll be cleared to volunteer at Lynn Road Elementary.
