## Raleigh Summer Youth Employment Program (RSYEP)

#### **Discover Your Future!**

The Raleigh Summer Youth Employment Program helps teens between the ages of 15 and 18 develop their skills and prepare for future employment by spending the summer working for the City of Raleigh.

Over seven weeks, 200 summer youth employees will gain valuable work experience, discover possible career pathways, and learn topics such as financial literacy, civic engagement, workforce soft skills, and leadership. Employees also have the opportunity to receive mentorship from firefighters, law enforcement staff, local business owners, and professionals from organizations such as Bank of America and UNC Health.

### What can you expect?

Employees will:



Be able to work in a virtual or in-person environment



Work 20-30 hours per week



Work hourly



Receive training and career counseling



Attend Life Skills and professional development trainings



Network and build relationships with coworkers and mentors

### Who can apply?

To be eligible, you must:

- Be age 15-18 as of May 31, 2023
- Live within the Raleigh city limits
- Be available to work June 20-August 4, 2023
- Attend program orientation on May 20, 2023.
- Be the only one in your household participating in this program
- If you choose the virtual option, must have computer and internet access
- Not miss more than 4 program days
- Not be enrolled in summer school
- Must have an NC State Issued ID, Learner's Permit, Driver's License, or current School Report Card that shows a Raleigh zip code at the time of interview. No exceptions.

\*Vaccination Information: As of September 2021, all new in-person/hybrid employees must be fully vaccinated against the COVID-19 virus for in-person employment. If there is a medical reason or sincerely held religious belief preventing you from receiving an available COVID-19 vaccination, and you are selected as a candidate for consideration, we have an accommodations process in place for those requests. For candidates that are interested in virtual/remote employment only, COVID-19 vaccination is not required.
