- Students are enrolled in 2 classes at a time
- Students earn a NC High School Diploma
- Students must come on-site at least once a week
- 4 campuses students can go to
- Two campuses open until 8PM
- Open 12 months out of the year
- No transportation provided
- No Honors, AP, or Foreign Language classes offered
- Students receive Pass/Fail grades for courses
- Student's GPA does not change while at SCORE.
 The GPA a student leaves their base school with will be the GPA they graduate with
- We have January & June graduation ceremonies
- Students are assigned a graduation coach and counselor for academic & social/emotional support
- Students cannot return to a comprehensive
 WCPSS high school after starting this program
