Officially established as a school in 2017, SCORE Academy is an alternative learning high school composed of two programs.

SCORE Academy-A serves as a re-engagement program for students between the ages of 16 and 21 who have significant barriers that prevent them from attending a traditional school.

SCORE Academy-B serves as a synchronous, blended learning program for students who have been reassigned to an alternative learning program by the Discipline Review Committee.

SCORE Academy operates out of three different locations in Wake County: Crossroads FLEX, Garner Station, and River Oaks annex.

SCORE Academy employs highly-qualified instructors, counselors, administrators, and additional support staff to ensure students have every opportunity to be successful.

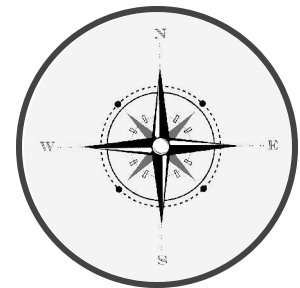

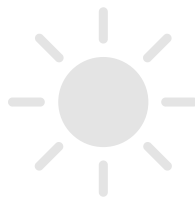

SCORE-A

Re-engagement: Students between the ages of 16-21 who have dropped out of school or are at risk of dropping out due to significant barriers



All coursework is completed asynchronous via Edgenuity



Full spectrum of support...counselors, personalized support plans, home visits



Three locations:
Cary
Raleigh
Garner



Teachers are Graduation Coaches: on-campus support, virtual support, weekly contact



Mastery based assignments= no tests



Operates on a 12 month calendar with rolling admissions



Students can graduate at any time

SCORE-B

Reassignment: Students in grades 9-12 who are assigned to SCORE as the result of a disciplinary infraction or denied enrollment at base school



All classes are live. Teachers use Canvas and Edgenuity



Counselors conduct monthly home visits



Students complete SEL course and are assigned to on-site cohorts



Full spectrum of support...counselors, personalized support plans, home visits



Students assigned to a site based on their base school



Traditional calendar/4x4 block



Students are offered Restorative Conference with base school
