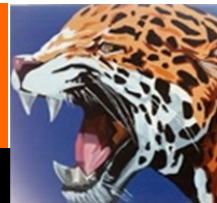

PARENT ORIENTATION SESSION

Parents, please plan to join us for our orientation session designed to make the transition to high school easier for you and your student. This will be an informational session in the auditorium hosted by our principal, Mr. Stephen Mares. Parents will learn what is expected of freshmen, including school policies and procedures, and how to get involved at Athens Drive. The parent orientation session begins at 8:05 am and will conclude around 9:10 am on August 15.

Jaguar Freshmen Camp

Q: Do I need to register to participate?

A: Students do not need to register to come to orientation. Although we would appreciate it if they did so that we can better prepare to welcome our newest Jags

Q: Where is it and when should I be there?

A: Camp activities will go from **8:00 am to 12:20 p.m.** at **Athens Drive Magnet High School**. **Students must be in the gym ready for the opening activity to begin promptly at 8:05 a.m.** Parents are invited to attend the parent orientation at the same time in the **auditorium**.

Q: What do I need to bring?

A: Students need to bring something to write with and should wear comfortable clothing and shoes suitable for walking the building. Clothing needs to comply with the WCPSS dress code. We will provide all students with a folder and appropriate paper work. The "Jag Junction" will be open so students can purchase Jaguar gear.

Q: How do I get there?

A: Parents will need to provide transportation to and from orientation for all students. **Athens Drive Activity Buses (Aqua Green and White) will be picking up and dropping off at the following locations as well: Raleigh Oaks Shopping Center at Lake Wheeler and Tryon, Carolina Pines Park Community Center, Kentwood Park (corner of Kentwood and Kaplan and Shopping center parking lot at Western and Method Road. Pick up times will be between 7:20 and 7:45 a.m.. Buses will drop off after the camp ends at 12:20.**

Students will participate in the following sessions:

Academic Planning: Counselors will guide freshmen through the transition to high school. Students **may** receive their schedules in this session.

Find Your Way Tour: Upperclassmen will help freshmen locate their classes and learn how to get around this very large campus.

Extracurricular Activities: Students will get to tour an "extracurricular fair" in the cafeteria, meet sponsors and coaches and learn about all of the ways to get involved at "The Drive".
