Attendance				
<ul> <li>Students are expected to take exams at the scheduled times, must be present at the beginning of the exam period to take the exam and must remain for the entire exam period to receive credit for the exam.</li> <li>VA students will take EOC/CTE exams at their base school. VA Teacher made exams will be given remotely.</li> <li>All State Exams are on campus each day.</li> <li>If absent, submit a parent note to the Attendance Office upon return to school. The student is responsible for working with the teacher to schedule the make-up exam date. All make-up state exams are given on computers.</li> <li>Students who do not have an EOC or make-up exam do not report to school June 10<sup>th</sup>. Students who remain on campus after the EOC or make-up exams conclude must remain in designated supervised areas (commons/media center).</li> </ul>				
Electronic Devices				
<ul> <li>According to North Carolina testing policy, students are not allowed to bring electronic devices (other than approved calculators) into the testing room at any time during state testing, including breaks.</li> <li>A student dismissed for a violation of the electronic device policy must take the missed exam on June 10<sup>th</sup>. Per WCPSS policy, the student is subject to disciplinary action by school administration.</li> </ul>				
Grading and Senior Exemptions				
<ul> <li>All final exams will count as 20% of the final grade, unless advised otherwise by the teacher.</li> <li>Per Board Policy 6000, seniors are not eligible for exemption from exams for courses with state testing requirements, including courses with End-of-Course Exams (Biology, English 2, Math 1 &amp; Math 3), and CTE Post Assessments.</li> </ul>
