#### AP EXAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

The College Board has changed the way Advanced Placement (AP) exam registration will work this year. All students who are enrolled in AP courses will now have access to amazing AP resources by "joining" the course online. All AP teachers have access to a unique join code per class and students will benefit from digital tools and AP exam question banks. For students taking AP courses in Fall, exam registration will take place in late October, as exams will be ordered in the beginning of November. For students taking AP courses in Spring, access to the online course will be granted in January and exam registration will be in March. Exams will be free again for students who are enrolled in the AP course. It is imperative to pay attention to exam ordering deadlines, as late order exams will cost the student \$134 fee, and exams canceled or not taken by the student will cost \$40.

- Apply for Financial Aid through FASFA.gov (Opened Oct 1st)
- Send your transcript through CommonApp, CFNC.org, or WCPSS.net/transcripts
- Send your test scores through Collegeboard. org or ACT.org
- Apply for Scholarships
