Green Level High was founded in 2019, accredited by Cognia in 2025, and is one of Wake County Public School System's 32 high schools. GLHS is Nationally Recognized for academics, athletics and arts. GLHS is an AP 2025 Platinum Honor Roll School. Our students participate in 35 varsity and junior varsity sports; over 120 leadership and service-oriented clubs; and a full range of course offerings including Honors, Advanced Placement and CTE Completers. The Class of 2022 was our first graduating class.
