### - PLEASE READ -

- Senior Exemptions (Teacher-Made Exams):**  
 Seniors may be exempt from teacher-made final exams if they have a projected final grade of B or higher and have 10 or fewer absences (including excused, unexcused, and educational leave) in the course. Seniors will be notified on Wednesday, June 4 if they qualify for an exam exemption. If a senior is exempt from their final exam(s), they do not need to attend "Review Day" or attend school on exam days.
- CTE/EOC State Exams:** All students must take their CTE and/or EOC state exams during their scheduled testing session(s).
- Teacher-Made Exams:** Teacher-made final exams (120-minute minimum) will take the form of a traditional assessment that assesses the course standards.
- Students must bring their charged and updated issued Chromebook to take their EOC/CTE exams.
- Exams will count as 20 percent of the student's final grade. If a student does not take the final exam, they will earn a zero for their exam grade.
- Students will be dismissed to the cafeteria when their exam session has ended and can be picked up at that time.
