COMMON APP ESSAY

SCHEDULE

- May-June
 - Begin thinking about who you want to write your teacher recommendations and reach out to them
 - Create a common app account and fill out the information that is about yourself
 - Brainstorm college essay ideas / writing rough drafts
- June-August
 - Begin looking at what colleges interest you
 - Create a list of your safety's, mid-level, and reaches
 - Set up visits for the colleges that are on your list
 - Find the colleges you plan to apply to on your common app and begin filling out their specific questions
 - START YOUR ESSAY
- August-December
 - Start of senior year!
 - Begin reviewing applications and submitting for early action/early decision
- December-February
 - Begin submitting for regular decision
 - Other colleges should begin to respond at this time
- February-March
 - Solidify your future plan
- March-June
 - Enjoy the rest of senior year!

- The BSMD/7-year program integrates undergraduate education with medical studies, allowing students to earn both a bachelor's and medical degree in seven years, accelerating their path to becoming doctors.
