

◆ WCPSS School-Issued Chromebook Info ◆

General Information

- Students are required to bring in a WCPSS-Issued Chromebook to school with them every day.
 - They are FREE for students.
 - WCPSS Testing browsers require a WCPSS Chromebook to access them.
 - Tech staff are not allowed to assist or repair students' personal devices.
- There is no longer a Bring Your Own Device Policy in place in Wake County.
 - Students are expected to use their Chromebook for classwork.
 - If a student is insistent on using their own device, they must have their charged and ready-to-use Chromebook with them as well.
- If a student damages their device, we may be able to replace it for them.
 - Students can receive 1 replacement in a 3 year period for screen or water damage without penalty.
 - If there is a 2nd case of screen or water damage, students will be put as a Day-Use Only user meaning they will need to pick up and return their device to the Media Center daily.

Expectations

- Bring a fully-charged device with you to class every single day.
- Report any issues to your teacher, media specialist, or WCPSS Student Help Desk as soon as possible.
- Do not remove your name label or provided cover from the device.
- Take care of your device and keep it clean.
- Use your device in accordance with the policies, rules, and expectations of WCPSS and PCHS.
