## A student's Guide To: Utilizing the 7 Habits of Highly Effective People during remote learning:

Habit 1: Be Proactive	<ul> <li>Take responsibility for your own learning</li> <li>Participate in class discussions</li> <li>Keep a notebook or planner with a to-do list + your daily schedule</li> <li>Ask questions</li> <li>Set an alarm for waking up in the morning &amp; for each of your class times</li> <li>Show up to class meetings prepared &amp; on time</li> </ul>	
Habit 2: Begin With The End In Mind	<ul> <li>Think about your goals</li> <li>Set short and long term goals for yourself (these can be overall goals or class specific goals)</li> <li>Tell a friend what your goals are &amp; make time to ask each other how they're going</li> <li>Share your goals with your teachers so they can help you reach them</li> </ul>	
Habit 3: Put First Things First	<ul> <li>Schedule your day</li> <li>Check Google Classroom each day and write down your assignments (either in a notebook/planner or using a digital tool)</li> <li>Organize your assignments based on your class times (ex. If math is your first period, do your math assignments/studying first)</li> </ul>	
Habit 4: Think Win-Win	Adopt an "everyone can win" attitude How can you share your work space at home with the people you live with?	
Habit 5: Seek First To Understand, Then To Be Understood	<ul> <li>Communication is key</li> <li>When in Google Meets with peers &amp; teachers, practice active listening</li> <li>Focus on the person who is speaking</li> <li>Ask questions if you don't understand</li> <li>Repeat back what the person said, so you make sure you understood correctly what they were sharing</li> <li>Remember, everyone is doing their best</li> </ul>
