Schedule Overview

The chart below provides an overview of schedule details when comparing Plan B blended instruction and the WCPSS Virtual Academy. We desire for the experience to be consistent between the learning environments.

What can students expect in terms of independent work that is not live with a teacher	While any school day will include independent work, students who are in person at the school will include the ability to access a teacher in real time.	Students can expect up to four hours of independent school work per day. The amount of time will vary based on students' needs, grade level, tasks and teacher discretion.	Students can expect up to approximately 2.5 hours of independent school work per day. The amount of time will vary based on students' needs, grade level, tasks and teacher discretion.

Live Instruction

To start school all students will be on Plan B Transition or VA, they will ALL receive 2 -3 hours of live instruction per day.

"Live" Instruction occurs at a designated time each day in the bell schedule. ALL students are expected to participate.

- Scheduled Collaborative Activities using digital tools with teacher involvement
- Peer feedback and collaboration activities where the teacher is also involved and providing feedback (example: using the comment feature in Google Docs to provide feedback).
- Discussion Questions / Forums moderated by the teacher
- Brief mini lessons through Google Meet to introduce a module of learning.
- Google Meet Chats (Whole Class or Small Group)

Non-Live Instruction

"Non-Live" Instruction involves opportunities to engage in learning activities independently of the teacher.

- Reading and/or annotating a text independently
- Resources that students can review independently (i.e. videos, text, etc.)
- Independent practice of skills
- Most writing activities
- Recorded videos of teacher presentations or skill demonstrations

In some instances students will be given flexibility to complete and participate in non-live instruction at times outside of the normal bell schedule.

Courses Offered in Plan B Transition vs. Virtual Academy

- All courses required for graduation will be offered in both settings
- AP and Honors courses will be offered in the Virtual Academy as well as Plan B Transition based on student requests
- Other electives will be offered to the extent possible:
 - Some CTE courses such as Carpentry, Vet Tech Assistant, Culinary Arts 2 and 3 will not be offered in Virtual Academy
 - Other electives such as Band, Dance, Arts, and other CTE courses will be offered based on student requests and the appropriateness of the course for fully online setting

Student Schedules

- Current schedules are not visible in PS at this point.
- There is a previous draft of the schedule that can be seen in parts of PS, but these versions are not necessarily correct.
- Schedules will be visible sometime around August 10th

Course Change Requests

- Student will be able to request course changes from August 12-August 19.
- Potential Reasons for a Course Change Request:
 - A student wants to increase rigor (moving from an Academic course to Honors course or an Honors course to an AP course)
 - A student is scheduled for a course they have previously passed
 - A student is missing a course needed to graduate (this applies to Seniors only)
 - A student has an incomplete schedule (holes in schedules will be filled with courses selected during the registration process OR classes with available space at the time of the request)
 - A student is scheduled for the same course twice
 - A student has a schedule with a sequencing issue (i.e. scheduled for Spanish II before Spanish I

Schedule Changes, con't

- Students **will not** be able to change their schedule because they no longer wish to take a course they requested or they prefer to have a different teacher.
- Schedule change request forms will be posted on the school website by the time schedules are live in PowerSchool.
- Counselors will email responses once the requests have been considered.
- Our schedule is tight; we will make accommodations as we possible.

Orientation

- Information for ninth grade parents will be posted on the WHS homepage the week of August 10.
- Ninth grade students will be able to tour the building once data suggests it is safe to return.
- The first two weeks of school will include instruction, meet and greet activities, and distribution of relevant information for our students.

Special Notes

Athletics, Marching Band, and Other Co-Curricular Activities Suspended Indefinitely

- Athletics will continue to follow all rules associated with the NC High School Athletic Association "dead Period."
- Band activities will be aligned with athletics as closely as possible.
- All other co-curricular activities that are suspended include any teacher-sponsored student clubs or organizations, such as ROTC, services clubs or national honor societies.

Off-Campus Lunch and Parking

- Off-campus lunch will not be permitted when students return to the building.
- WHS is awaiting information from district officials as to how parking will be handled this year.
