Career and College Promise, or CCP, allows eligible high school students to take college courses at Wake Tech. For detailed information go to: <https://www.waketech.edu/admissions-aid/career-and-college-promise>

The Enrollment Process for Summer 2021 and Fall 2021 classes is now open!

CCP offers two pathways, depending on a student’s goals. Each pathway includes specific coursework.

The Career and Technical Education Pathway (CTE) leads to a credential for employment (certificate, diploma, or degree). The College Transfer Pathway (CT) leads to credit hours that count toward a two-year associate’s degree at Wake Tech and align with course requirements at UNC member institutions.

The enrollment process, requirements and deadlines can all be found on the CCP website. Here are three very important notes...

1. When completing the CCP forms online, all students should enter Mr. Greene’s email as the contact person for LRHS. His email is egreene@wcpss.net.
2. Students should email Mr. Greene from their school email to receive a transcript for their application.
3. Grades from CCP classes DO go on the high school transcript and impact GPA. Classes received 1 extra GPA point.
