STOUGH MANDARIN IMMERSION MAGNET ELEMENTARY



STOUGH

Beginning in kindergarten, students take each of the four core classes (literacy, social studies, math and science) in Mandarin. Additionally, beginning in kindergarten, students have a daily English literacy class to ensure that standard vocabulary and reading patterns are developed. Beginning in third grade, the program transitions from a 90/10 model to a 80/20 model to ensure that additional math skills in English are acquired.

OBERLIN

Sixth (6th) and seventh (7th) grade immersion students receive two periods daily in the target language, Spanish or Mandarin Chinese. One class is Spanish or Mandarin Chinese literacy development and the second class Social Studies.

Eighth grade (8th) grade students receive one literacy class daily in the target language, Spanish or Mandarin Chinese.

If the required objectives are satisfactorily completed during 8th grade, students have the option to receive up high school World Language credit for their K-8 immersion work.

BROUGHTON

Students have the opportunity to continue language acquisition in their target language World Language classes. Students are encouraged to take Spanish or Mandarin Chinese 3 or 4 during the 9th grade year, the corresponding AP courses/test and participate in the IB Diploma Programme.
