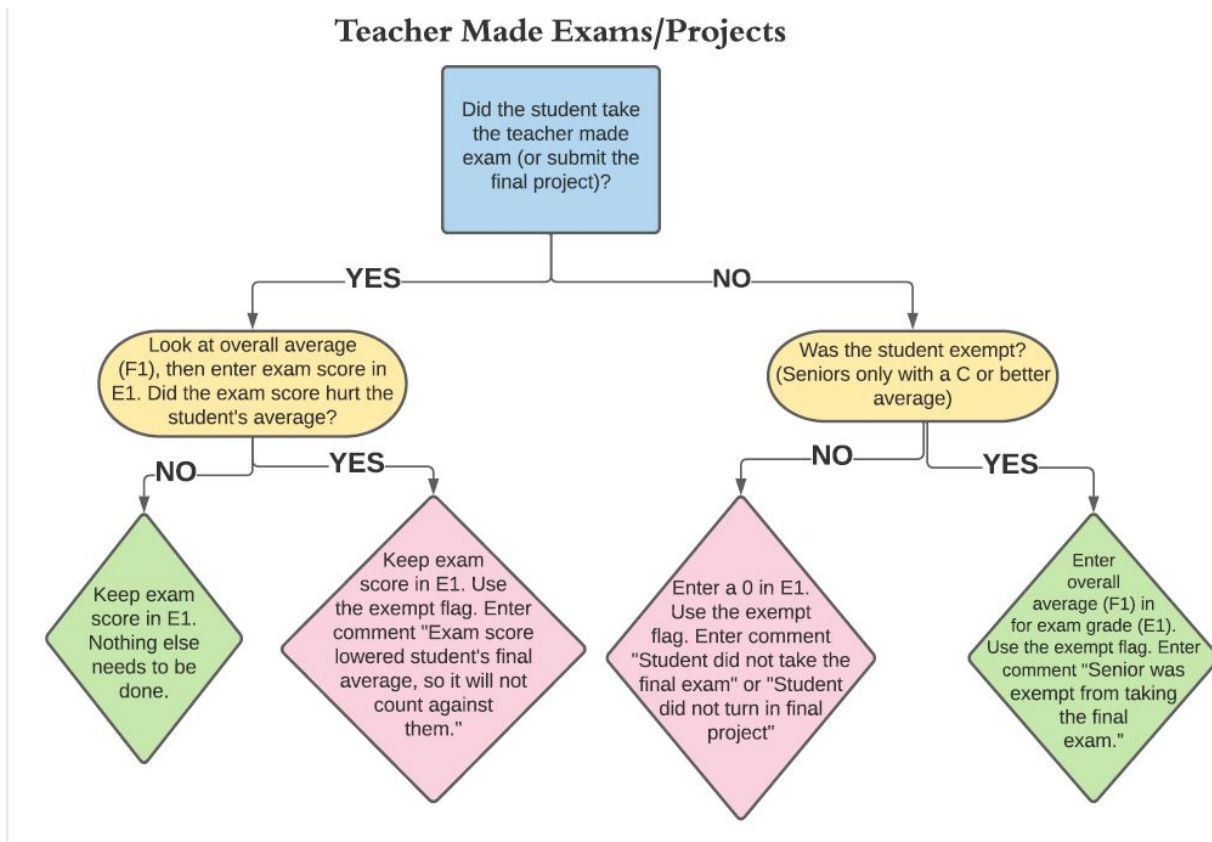

<p>All courses other than: Eng. 2, Math 1, Math 3, Biology</p> <p>CTE Courses: Accounting, I and II, Apparel I & II, Career Management, Child Development, Principles of Family and Human Services, Fashion and Merchandising, Foundations of Health Science, Foods I & II, Health Science I, Principles of Business and Finance, Child Development, & Sports and Entertainment Marketing I</p>	<p><i>Students will be exempt from their exam for any course that does not require state testing and for which the student has a final average of C or better. For the 2020-2021 school year, absences will not be considered in the determination of senior exam exemptions.</i></p>
