## What is NC Check-In?

On Wednesday, February 24, your student will have the opportunity to participate in the NC Check-In Assessment. Neuse River is participating in the Reading and Math NC Check-In. This is an excellent opportunity! The NC Check-Ins are a practice test to guide and prepare students for the End-Of-Grade (EOG) test at the end of the school year. If your child participates in the NC Check-In, parents will receive a copy of your students' performance on each assessment. *The NC Check-In is an optional opportunity. Your student will not be penalized if they do not participate.*

**How will my student take the test?** Using the table below, determine which route your student will take to be able to participate in the NC Check-In at Neuse River.

**How long does each NC Check-In take?** Each assessment (Math and Reading) should take approximately 90 minutes.

**Why are we coming to school for this assessment?** Similar to EOGs that will be administered at the end of the year, students must access the test from a WCPSS device. We have students that do not have a WCPSS device and we are offering this opportunity to allow for all students to be able to complete the assessment. ***This is not required, but highly recommended.***

Your student will only be able to access the NC Check-In through this portal.</p> <p><b>Suggested Testing Schedule:</b> 8:00-9:30am - NC Check In Reading 9:30-11:00am - NC Check In Math</p> <p>**Students can take breaks as needed.</p>	<p>Your student will need to <u>report to school</u> to take the NC Check-In.</p> <p><b>You must provide your own transportation.</b></p> <p>Complete the following form by <b>Monday, February 22</b>, to sign up for your student to attend school for the NC Check-In.</p> <p><a href="#">CLICK HERE TO COMPLETE FORM</a></p> <p><b>Testing Date:</b> Wednesday - *February 24, 2021 which is an ASYNCHRONOUS DAY</p> <p><b>Arrival:</b> Student Drop-Off - 7:30am in the Bus Loop Testing will begin promptly at 8:00am</p> <p><b>Food:</b> Lunch will <u>not</u> be provided, however, if your child would like to bring a snack, a break will be provided.</p> <p><b>Pick-up Time:</b> Testing will end around 11:30am. Students can be picked up between 11:30am-12:00noon.</p> <p><b>**Safety Protocols:</b> All students will be required to go through the health screening process prior to entering the building and all safety protocols including social distancing will be followed during testing.</p>
