
Our innovative schedule incorporates two electives per day for 1st-5th grades and one elective per day for Kindergarten. We offer extensive elective choices in visual and performing arts, world languages, as well as core subjects. Students have the opportunity to experience up to eight electives per academic year.

Through our AIG Basics program, 4th-5th grade students who are formally identified by WCPSS as academically or intellectually gifted are grouped for core instruction with similarly-identified students. Advanced learners in the early grades are provided with enrichment opportunities through AIG elective courses, content differentiation, and the Explorers program at grade 3. We




