Frequently Asked Questions

Question	Answer
 Can I take my end of grade tests at home? 	No, all end of grade tests will be administered in person at school on your assigned day.
2. What time does the test start?	We will start testing each day at 8:15am
3. What day is my child testing?	6th Grade Reading: May 26th 6th Grade Math: May 27th

4. How long does the test take?	Testing typically takes approximately 3 hours.
5. Will I be able to ride the bus to school to take the test?	If you registered to participate in the EOG, you had a choice to select district transportation. All requests for district transportation have been submitted. As soon as your child is assigned to one of our current bus routes, we will let you know.

6. Will I be able to eat breakfast/lunch?	If you registered to participate, you had a choice for your child to receive breakfast and/or lunch.
7. What happens if I do not feel comfortable having my child participate due to COVID-19?	If you selected on the survey that you do not feel comfortable having your child come to campus due to COVID-19, your child will not participate in the end of grade testing this school year.
8. What happens if my child does not participate in the end of grade test?	There are no negative consequences if your child does not participate in the test due to COVID-19 concerns. It will not be used for promotion or retention.
9. Can my child leave when they complete the test?	Yes, your child will be allowed to call a parent to be picked up.
10. Can my child stay at school to ride the bus home at the end of the school day?	Yes, if you registered for bus transportation, your child can stay until the end of the school day. They will be placed in classes with their peers until it is time to leave at the end of the day.
11. How large are the test groups?	Students will test in group sizes between 25-30.
12. Will my child have to wear a mask?	Yes, we are required to wear our masks while in the school building
13. Will there be social distancing?	We will have approximately 3 feet of social distancing while testing.
