All <u>teacher-made exams</u> will be administered during the corresponding class period. In-person students will take their exams in-person and Virtual Academy students will take their exams virtually.

All <u>state-standardized exams</u> (EOC and some CTE ) will be administered <u>on campus</u> during the corresponding class period. This applies to all students whether enrolled in PC or PCVA (including NCVPS courses).

- EOCs: Math 1, Math 3, English 2, Biology
- CTE: based on course and whether other credential exams are completed

Senior Exemptions - Seniors will be exempt from their exam for any course that does not require state testing and for which the student has a final average of C or better. Absences will not be considered in the determination of senior exam exemptions. Note: All Seniors in a CTE course must have a POL (Proof of Learning) - they are not exempt. The CTE teacher will provide more detail.

## Final Exam Information 2021-2022

- All final exams will count 20% of the student's final course grade.
- Exams can positively or negatively impact the final course grade depending on the exam grade.
- If a student does not take the exam, a zero will be averaged as 20% of the final course grade.
- Breakfast and Lunch will be made available to students on exam days.
- Students who do not have an exam scheduled on a particular day do not report to campus that day.
- Students may not be checked out earlier than the end of the exam session (11:45am).

## State EOC/CTE Exams

- All state exams (EOC and some CTE) will be administered in-person/on-campus for all students enrolled in a course with one of these exams (including Virtual Academy students).
  - EOCs: NC Math 1, NC Math 3, English 2, Biology
  - Specific CTE courses teacher will communicate to students and list is on slide 6
  - All health and safety protocols will be followed while students are on campus.
- State exams are 20% of the final course grade.

# **Virtual Academy Information**

- Virtual Academy students who are eligible for transportation can request bus transportation to PCHS for on-campus exams. A link will be sent to VA students through their student email.
- Virtual Academy students enrolled in an NCVPS course requiring a state EOC or CTE exam will take the exam on our campus.
- Virtual Academy students who have an EOC or CTE state exam will be assigned a class period to take their exam on campus based on the PCHS exam schedule. The assigned period may not align to what is listed in PowerSchool.
  - This information will be sent to the student email address.
- Teacher-made exams for Virtual Academy students will be asynchronous.

## **Checkout on Exam Days**

- On exam days, students can checkout early after the morning exam session is complete (11:45am). As normal, parent permission is required for school checkout - a form will be provided.
- Students who do not checkout will report to the assigned class period that is on the test schedule after lunch for supervision (12:21 2:18pm).

\*\*\*Checkout forms will be distributed and collected through 2nd period teachers. \*\*\*Virtual Academy students coming in for an exam will receive additional directions about the checkout form in the student email.
