Notes:

1. For all courses, the final exam is worth 20% of the student's final grade. This includes End-of-Course (EOC) Exams, Career and Technical Education (CTE), or Teacher-Made Assessments. Assessments are required for all courses.

- 2. Teachers giving a teacher-made assessment have the option of assessing students through a traditional exam on June 7 and 8 or through a project-based assessment assigned ahead of time or presented on June 7 and 8. It is the responsibility of the teacher to clearly communicate with students about the expectations of this assessment. Should attendance on June 7 and 8 not be required, students need not attend.
- 3. Students must be present at the beginning of each exam period to take the exam, should a traditional exam be assigned. Students must plan to be present for the entire exam period. Students will not have access to cell phones during their exam period.
- 4. On June 6, **only** students with a scheduled EOC should report to campus. Students should only attend exam periods on June 7 and 8 if an exam is required. On June 9 and 10, **only** students with a scheduled make up exam should report to campus.
- 5. Virtual Academy students are required to take state exams on campus. Virtual Academy students will receive an email with assigned exam date, time, and room.
- 6. **Seniors** with a C or better in a course with a teacher made exam can be exempt from the final exam. Seniors **cannot** be exempt from CTE or EOC exams.
- 7. **Buses** will run at 2:18 on Monday, June 6, Thursday, June 9, and Friday, June 10. Buses will run at 1:15 on Tuesday, June 7 and Wednesday June 8.
- 8. **Make-up teacher-made exams** will be administered by appointment with the teacher.
- 9. Students who are on campus during an exam period for which they do not have an exam on June 7 or 8 must report to their assigned classroom for that class period.
- 10. The campuses of Leesville Road Elementary School and Leesville Road Middle School, as well as other Wake County schools, are strictly off limits on these dates to Leesville Road High School students.
