ESTABLISHED Our school was established in 2012 to provide a rigorous and engaging educational experience that allows students to 2 years of free transferrable college credits. Wake Young Women's Academy is the only single-gender public school for young women in Wake County.

CAMPUS LOCATION | Students in grades 6 – 10 are located on the historic Governor Morehead Campus. Students in grades 11 – 13 are located on the historic Saint Augustine's University Campus.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS Our students are engaged in a rigorous and challenging course of study that is designed to meet 95% of high school graduation requirements before 11th grade. We offer advanced level courses that provide a foundation for future success. We limit elective offerings to ensure college readiness by the end of grade 10. As a STEM school, our students utilize the engineering design process and project based learning across all disciplines. Our students score well above their peers in other Central Area Magnet schools.

EXTENDED LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES Our students are engaged in a variety of activities to extend learning beyond the classroom. These activities include site-based learning excursions, seminars, guest speakers, job shadowing, internships, community service, and leadership development.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES| We offer over 16 clubs and organizations that allow students to demonstrate their leadership skills. Our partnerships with Daniels Middle and Broughton High allow interested students to also participate in athletics.
