SCORE Academy's vision for Parent and Family Engagement includes the following collaborative actions to ensure a Restorative educational experience for all students and parents.

- Twice a semester we will facilitate Parent Engagement night (English/Spanish). A circle process will be utilized to maximize parent input, participation and to build community.
- Every student that enrolls will have an in-person orientation in which parents are obligated to attend.
- All staff has been trained in facilitating circles and are required to complete a restorative practice book study. These activities provide our staff an assortment of resources to serve our student and families with a restorative lens.
- Parents can become a member of SCORE Academy's Student Services Advisory Council (Meets twice a year).
- Parents are provided the opportunity to be a member of our School Improvement Team.
- Ensure that our parents with limited English proficiency and families with disabilities are considered and accommodated in every aspect of our policy.
