



# CCP Questions & Answers



## Who is eligible for this program?

-11th & 12th Graders - You need to have an unweighted GPA of 2.8 to participate.

-9th & 10th Graders - Your requirements are described in detail on their website The main requirement is that you must be AIG-identified.

\**SUMMER* - Started Feb. 3rd

\**FALL* - Application goes live March 1st

## How do I request my transcript to apply for the CCP program?

### CCP Transcript Request:

- Go to <https://wcpss.scribborder.com/>
- Click on the backpack
- Complete the required star items in the form.
- If you don't have a drivers license, you can click on the ? and select "Do Not Have ID"
- Enter your delivery address as your personal address.
- Under Select the Information type, select College and Career Promise
- At the bottom, type your initials and sign your name
- Click the Update Fees - Prepare For Checkout

## How do I register for my HSHS classes if I am planning to take Wake Tech CCP classes?

During registration at HSHS you will register for 8 classes and 4 alternate electives. Once you have been accepted into the Wake Tech program and fully registered for your Wake Tech classes, you must complete the Dual Enrollment Form and the Early Release/Late Arrival Form. These forms will be sent to you in an email.

## Do I have to leave HSHS Campus if I am enrolled in a CCP course?

**YES**, all students **must** leave campus if they are taking off a block to take Wake Tech CCP course. This is outlined in the *Early Release/Late Arrival form*.

## Do I have to choose a pathway when I register? What are the pathways?

Everyone **MUST** choose a pathway when applying to Wake Tech.

This is a requirement that many students struggle with understanding. There are two directions a student can go... **College Transfer Pathway or Career & Technical Pathway.**

Each pathway has very specific courses that are available for you to take. Please make sure you look at each detailed sheet of the Pathways to understand what classes are available for you to take.

## Can I take Wake Tech CCP classes online or in person?

-Wake Tech has many options. They have online asynchronous, hybrid, and scheduled classes, as well as in-person classes.

-Their classes are typically 12 weeks but they do have accelerated 8 week course also. PLEASE make sure you know what you are registering for when picking out classes.

## When registering for ENG111 I am getting a prerequisite error, what am I doing wrong?

Make sure you are not choosing a course that has a G at the end of the course code. These course are not for CCP students.

## If I am already a CCP student, do I need to reapply every semester?

**YES**, all students must apply to the program. Continuing students will choose to fill out the Continuing Students Form.

## What courses can I take at WTCC that count for high school credit? Do any of them meet our graduation requirements?

-All of the courses that earn you 3 credits at Wake Tech in the CCP program will be put on your transcript for 1 high school credit.

-The GPA weight depends on the course. For example, all courses in the College Transfer Pathway will earn you an additional 1 point weight for your GPA, this is not true for all classes in the Career & Technical Pathway.

-There are very few classes at Wake Tech that meet a graduation requirement. The most popular for students is if you take HIS131 and HIS 132 you will meet the American History graduation requirement. Students MUST be in the College Transfer Pathway - Associates in Arts achieve this.
