Expectations in your Designated Area

- ☐ ONCE YOU ARE IN AN AREA, YOU WILL REMAIN THERE UNTIL THE BELL RINGS AT 7:18 AM
- ☐ IN YOUR DESIGNATED AREA, STUDENTS ARE SEATED AND NOT LOITERING
- ☐ YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO HANG OUT IN LARGE GROUPS
- ☐ BREAKFAST/FOOD/DRINKS MUST REMAIN IN THE CAFETERIA
- ☐ ONCE THE BELL RINGS, YOU WILL TRANSITION TO YOUR FIRST CLASS





Procedures for Hallway Transitions

- ☐ THERE WILL BE NO LOITERING (HANGING OUT) IN THE HALLWAYS
- ☐ FOR YOUR SAFETY
 - YOU WILL BE DISMISSED BY YOUR TEACHER/ANNOUNCEMENT
 - YOU MUST WALK ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE HALLWAY
- ☐ TEACHERS WILL NOT RELEASE ANY STUDENT FROM THEIR CLASS DURING THE FIRST OR LAST 15 MINUTES OF CLASS; PLAN ACCORDINGLY (15-15 RULE)

Restroom Expectations

- ☐ YOU MUST OBTAIN PERMISSION AND A PASS FROM YOUR TEACHER TO LEAVE THE CLASSROOM OR USE THE RESTROOM
- ☐ WHEN GOING TO THE RESTROOM, ONLY USE THE BATHROOM THAT IS LABELED ON YOUR COLORED PASS
- ☐ NO WANDERING OR "WALKING THE HALLS"
- ☐ AGAIN, NO PASS = CANNOT LEAVE CLASS





Classroom Expectations



STUDENTS WILL EXHIBIT PRIDE BY:

- USING THE ANTI-BACTERIAL GEL NEAR THE DOOR WHEN ENTERING AND EXITING THE CLASSROOM
- FOLLOWING THE DIRECTIONS OF THE TEACHER THE FIRST TIME GIVEN
- MAKING SURE YOUR PHONE IS AWAY/OUT OF SIGHT
- IMMEDIATELY SETTING UP FOR CLASS AND BEGINNING YOUR "WARM-UP" OR BELLRINGER



In Class Expectations



STUDENTS WILL EXHIBIT PRIDE BY:

- RESPECTING AND COOPERATING WITH STAFF AND OTHER STUDENTS
- FOLLOWING CLASSROOM NORMS ESTABLISHED BY STUDENTS AND TEACHERS

Cell Phone Policy

- ☐ YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO USE YOUR CELL PHONE IN THE CLASSROOM
- ☐ CELL PHONES ARE TO BE USED WHEN GIVEN PERMISSION BY THE TEACHER WHOSE CLASS YOU ARE IN OR IF IT IS AN APPROVED "BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE"
- ☐ THE PHONE IS TO BE PUT AWAY AND TURNED OFF/MUTED DURING CLASS
- ☐ FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE POLICY WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION AND/OR THE PHONE WILL BE CONFISCATED



Cell Phone Consequences

- ☐ **TEACHERS SHOULD DEVELOP CELL PHONE PROCEDURES FOR THEIR CLASSROOMS THAT LEVERAGE THE DEVICE FOR LEARNING.**
- ☐ **TEACHERS SHOULD CONTACT THE FRONT OFFICE FOR ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANCE IF THE STUDENT REFUSES TO COMPLY WITH TEACHER DIRECTIVE FOR CELL PHONE USE.**
- ☐ **ADMINISTRATIVE CONSEQUENCES:**
 - ☐ **1. PHONE IS CONFISCATED. STUDENT MAY PICK UP AFTER SCHOOL.**
 - ☐ **2. PHONE IS CONFISCATED. PARENT MUST PICK UP AFTER SCHOOL.**
 - ☐ **3. ADMINISTRATOR DISCRETION.**





Lunch Expectations

- ☐ **STUDENTS WILL FOLLOW ALL GUIDELINES WHILE IN LINE OR SITTING AT A TABLE. STUDENTS WILL FOLLOW DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY TEACHERS IN THEIR ZONE. CUTTING IN LINE CAN RESULT IN BEING SENT TO THE BACK OF THE LINE**
- ☐ **PLACE ALL TRASH IN THE WASTE BINS AND ENSURE YOUR TABLES AND FLOOR AREA ARE CLEAN**

- ☐ NO FOOD DELIVERY SERVICES ARE ALLOWED (GRUB HUB, DOORDASH, PANERA, ETC.)
- ☐ IF YOU LEAVE CAMPUS WITHOUT PERMISSION, YOU ARE SUBJECT TO BE SEARCHED WHEN YOU RETURN
- ☐ DESIGNATED AREAS AT LUNCH ARE THE GREAT HALL, COURTYARD, CAFETERIA, AND PICNIC TABLES OUTSIDE CAFETERIA. BEING OUT OF AREA AT LUNCH WILL BE AN ADMINISTRATIVE REFERRAL

- ☐ YOU MAY LEAVE ONLY WHEN DISMISSED BY YOUR TEACHER AT THE DESIGNATED TIME FOR RELEASE
- ☐ REMAIN ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE HALLWAY
- ☐ GO DIRECTLY TO YOUR DESIGNATED AREA (BUS, CARPOOL, WALKER)
- ☐ ATHLETES MEET THEIR RESPECTIVE COACH IN THE AREA DESIGNATED BY YOUR COACH IMMEDIATELY AFTER SCHOOL
- ☐ LOUNGING IN THE GREAT HALL CAN RESULT IN ADMINISTRATIVE CONSEQUENCES OR LOSS OF PRIVILEGES
