

## **Latest Drivers Ed Information for SRHS Students**

July 26, 2020, Driver Education Update

### **Behind-the-Wheel:**

BTW has started back July 13 with a reduced work force and we will proceed as scheduled prior to the closure. We will work through each class session based on age within the class, oldest to youngest. As you all know, this situation has compromised everyone's typical schedules and processes.

We are currently working with February classroom students, and then will proceed through the original rosters that were completed remotely during May, June, and July. The process is expected to take some time, especially with the advent of "school day hours" and time requirements.

Sometimes a younger student is scheduled prior to an older one due to answering the phone or general availability for a time sensitive schedule. If you have a phone setting that does not allow your phone to ring with an unrecognized number, you might want to turn it off.

I will only move someone up if the student is about to turn 18.

Each driver has been trained on safety protocols and has specific directions to follow that are not negotiable.

### **Classroom Sessions:**

We completed all spring scheduled sessions through online instruction.

There are no additional "summer" classes planned and registration for the "school year" has not yet begun. Once we know how to proceed based on WCPSS fall 2020 plans, available trained personnel, and appropriate in-place procedures, Jordan Driving School will open the registration process.

Students are placed in a class based on age, with the oldest students given priority. The fee is \$65.00, payable online, and covers the classroom and the BTW lessons. The certificate of completion is provided at the conclusion of BTW.

### **Applicable DMV Information:**

If your child has a valid Driving Eligibility Certificate (DEC) issued by their school that was dated between *Feb. 9, 2020 and March 10, 2020*, that certificate will be accepted by the Division of Motor Vehicles for up to 30 days after all DMV offices have been reopened.

The DEC can be issued to you via the Student Services Offices by appointment only.

Required DMV Vision Checks have been offered in June and in July at 6 area sites, two days each month. There will be one more offered in August, prior to the "return to school".
